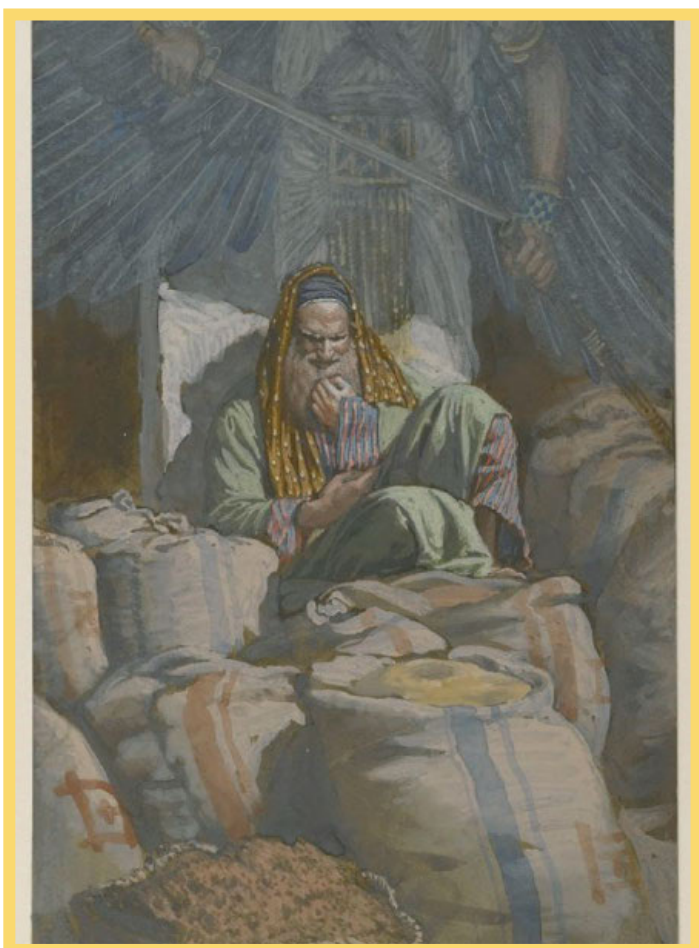

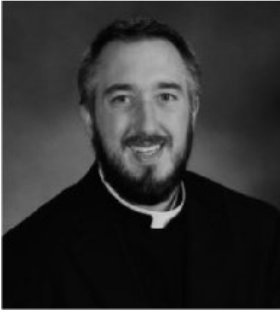

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR



When you think about the bible, many times we want to hear uplifting words to encourage us on our journey. And then we hear things like what is said in the first reading, Vanity of vanities, says Qoheleth, vanity of vanities! All things are vanity! This does not seem very uplifting at first. But it is not a call to despair either. It is a call to put all things into perspective.

As Qoheleth meditates on life he realizes the same end comes to all regardless of what they did in life. All of us are on the same trajectory. At first when we think about the fact that we are going to die it can be depressing and sad. But if we realize, what death is it does not have to be so.

Death is a door to eternity and whether it opens to heaven or hell is up to us. There is no greater waste of time in this life than to be so focused on things and experiences that we negate our relationship with God and neighbor. That is true vanity to be so focused on ourselves that fail to truly live as God wants us to in love with him and our neighbor.

This is what Jesus also says in the gospel. There is the man who has good harvests and plans to live the comfortable life, but he did not have that much life left. He was relying upon his own good efforts for enjoying life.

Now here is the thing, Jesus does tell us these things so that we will feel bad, but rather that we will know the eternal truths and choose the best thing with the outlook for eternity. There are many apparent goods in this world, but not all of them are truly good in the long run. Take for example all the forms of social media. Wouldn't you think that with a relationship only as far away as the nearest smartphone or computer would lead us to a better world as we are now better connected. But it doesn't. There are many people who are connected socially but are lonely and lack true friendship.

Mysteriously we live in a world where the suicide rate has gone up thirty percent between 2000 and 2020. You would think it would be the opposite as social media has grown over this same period of time and we would think that the rate would have gone down. Social media is not fulfilling peoples need for friendship and love.

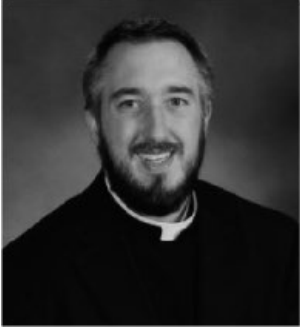
If you look again at what Jesus and Qoheleth are saying, it is not to give up on life. Rather it is deeper. Do the things that count. Have a good relationship with God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Be one of God's friends hang out with God in silent time with him and spend time talking to him. Share this friendship with others. Tell people about the great love he has for you and the many good things he has done for you in life. Take time to serve others even when it is most inconvenient.

What you will notice is that building a friendship with God, leading people to a friendship with God, helping others, serving others; all these are signs of love and love never fails, it never rots. The only thing we ever must worry about is love growing cold because we do not do the things out of love. But if we continue to nurture and live it, love grows stronger and burns brighter in our life. Then one day when we are called from this earth, we will have a great treasure that has been stored up for all eternity. The treasure of love. Nothing on this earth, and no power of the enemy can destroy love. It is from God who is love, and our response is love. This is the great treasure of treasures for eternity.

CARTA DEL PÁRRACO



Cuando piensas en la Biblia, muchas veces queremos escuchar palabras edificantes para animarnos en nuestro viaje. Y luego escuchamos cosas como lo que se dice en la primera lectura, Vanidad de vanidades, dice Qohélet, vanidad de vanidades! ¡Todas las cosas son vanidad! Esto no parece muy edificante al principio. Pero tampoco es una llamada a la desesperación. Es un llamado a poner todas las cosas en perspectiva.

Mientras Qohélet medita sobre la vida, se da cuenta de que el mismo fin llega a todos, independientemente de lo que hayan hecho en la vida. Todos estamos en la misma trayectoria. Al principio, cuando pensamos en el hecho de que vamos a morir, puede ser deprimente y triste. Pero si nos damos cuenta de lo que es la muerte, no tiene por qué ser así.

La muerte es una puerta a la eternidad y si se abre al cielo o al infierno, eso depende de nosotros. No hay mayor pérdida de tiempo en esta vida que estar tan concentrado en cosas y experiencias que negamos nuestra relación con Dios y el prójimo. Esa es verdadera vanidad estar tan centrados en nosotros mismos que no logramos vivir verdaderamente como Dios quiere que vivamos enamorados de él y de nuestro prójimo.

Esto es lo que Jesús también dice en el evangelio. Está el hombre que tiene buenas cosechas y planes para vivir una vida cómoda, pero no le quedó tanta vida. Estaba confiando en sus propios buenos esfuerzos para disfrutar de la vida.

Ahora aquí está la cosa, Jesús nos dice estas cosas, no para que nos sintamos mal, sino que conozcamos las verdades eternas y escojamos lo mejor con la perspectiva de la eternidad. Hay muchos bienes aparentes en este mundo, pero no todos son realmente buenos a largo plazo. Tomemos, por ejemplo, todas las formas de las redes sociales. Pensarías que una relación lejana sería tan cercana como al tener el teléfono o la computadora tan cercas a nosotros y nos llevaría a un mundo mejor ya que ahora estamos mejor conectados, Pero no es así. Hay muchas personas que están conectadas socialmente pero se sienten solas y carecen de una verdadera amistad.

Misteriosamente, vivimos en un mundo donde la tasa de suicidios aumentó un treinta por ciento entre 2000 y 2020. Uno pensaría que sería lo contrario, ya que las redes sociales crecieron durante este mismo período de tiempo y pensaríamos que la tasa habría bajado. Las redes sociales no satisfacen la necesidad de amistad y amor de las personas.

Si miras de nuevo lo que Jesús y Qohélet están diciendo, no es renunciar a la vida. Más bien es más profundo. Has las cosas que cuentan. Tener una buena relación con Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Sea uno de los amigos de Dios, pase tiempo con Dios en silencio con él y pase tiempo hablando con él. Comparte esta amistad con los demás. Cuéntale a la gente sobre el gran amor que te tiene y las muchas cosas buenas que ha hecho por ti en la vida. Tómese el tiempo para servir a los demás, incluso cuando sea más inconveniente.

Lo que notará es que construir una amistad con Dios, llevar a las personas a una amistad con Dios, ayudar a los demás, servir a los demás; todos estos son signos de amor, y el amor nunca falla, nunca se pudre. Lo único que nos debe preocupar es que el amor se enfríe porque no hacemos las cosas con amor. Pero si continuamos nutriendo y viviendo el amor, el amor se vuelve más fuerte y brilla más en nuestra vida. Entonces, un día, cuando seamos llamados de esta tierra, tendremos un gran tesoro que ha sido guardado para toda la eternidad. El tesoro del amor. Nada en esta tierra, y ningún poder del enemigo puede destruir el amor. Es de Dios que es amor, y nuestra respuesta es amor. Este es el gran tesoro de los tesoros para la eternidad.

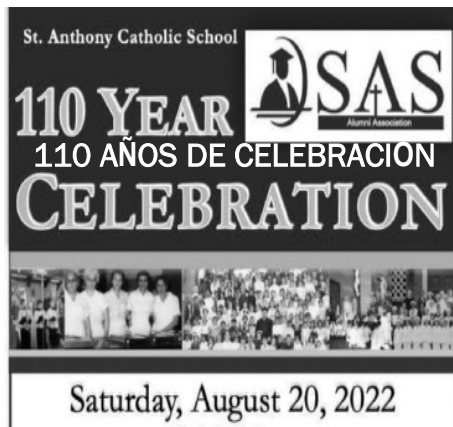
