FR. WELDON'S CORNER

"Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up to heaven?" (*Acts 1:11*). The question has to do with our attitude to two basic realities which shape every human life: earth and heaven. We stand on earth because our Maker made us as the crowning work of his creation, made in his own image and likeness. He gave them the dignity of being children of God and the gift of immortality. Man fell by rejecting God and saying No, but God entered directly into human history, which then became a history of salvation. "We stand" on the earth, we are rooted in the earth and we grow from it in the midst of our daily joys and sufferings. So we ask, "Is this all there is? Is this earth on which "we stand" our final destiny? The apostles stood there looking up to heaven because they looked to Jesus Christ, the Crucified and Risen One, raised up on high. At a distance of two thousand years, the meaning of that event is quite clear. Here on earth, we are called to look up to heaven, to turn our minds and hearts to the inexpressible mystery of God. We are called to look towards this divine reality, to which we have been directed from our creation. For there we find life's ultimate meaning. Pope Benedict XVI 28 May 2006

From the "Letter to Diognetus", an anonymous early Christian letter explaining the Christian life during ancient pagan Rome. Written before the 4th century. "...we may say that the Christian is to the world what the soul is to the body. As the soul is present in every part of the body, while remaining distinct from it, so Christians are found in all the cities of the world, but cannot be identified with the world. As the visible body contains the invisible soul, so Christians are seen living in the world, but their religious life remains unseen. The body hates the soul and wars against it, not because of any injury the soul has done it, but because of the restriction the soul places on its pleasures. Similarly, the world hates the Christians, not because they have done it any wrong, but because they are opposed to its enjoyments."

Hombres de Galilea, "¿Qué hacen ahí mirando al cielo?". Esta pregunta se refiere a dos actitudes relacionadas con las dos realidades en las que se inscribe la vida del hombre: la terrena y la celeste...Estamos en la tierra porque el Creador nos ha puesto aquí como coronamiento de la obra de la creación. Dios todopoderoso, de acuerdo con su inefable designio de amor, creó el cosmos, lo sacó de la nada. El hombre se extravió, abusó del don de la libertad y dijo "no" a Dios, pero Dios mismo no se resignó a esa situación y entró directamente en la historia del hombre, que se convirtió en historia de la salvación. "Estamos en la tierra", estamos arraigados en ella, de ella crecemos. Aquí experimentamos el cansancio de los viandantes en camino hacia la meta por sendas escabrosas, en medio de vacilaciones, tensiones, incertidumbres, pero también con la profunda conciencia de que antes o después este camino llegará a su término. Y entonces surge la reflexión: ¿Esto es todo? ¿La tierra en la que "nos encontramos" es nuestro destino definitivo? Así pues, los apóstoles estaban mirando fijamente al cielo, dado que acompañaban con la mirada a Jesucristo, crucificado y resucitado, que era elevado. Estamos llamados a mirar hacia esta realidad divina, a la que hemos sido dirigidos desde nuestra creación. Porque allí encontramos el sentido último de la vida. "... los cristianos son en el mundo lo que el alma es en el cuerpo. El alma, en efecto, se halla esparcida por todos los miembros del cuerpo; así también los cristianos se encuentran dispersos por todas las ciudades del mundo. El alma habita en el cuerpo, pero no procede del cuerpo; los cristianos viven en el mundo, pero no son del mundo. El alma invisible está encerrada en la cárcel del cuerpo visible; los cristianos viven visiblemente en el mundo, pero su religión es invisible. La carne aborrece y combate al alma, sin haber recibido de ella agravio alguno, sólo porque le impide disfrutar de los placeres; también el mundo aborrece a los cristianos, sin haber recibido agravio de ellos, porque se oponen a sus placeres."

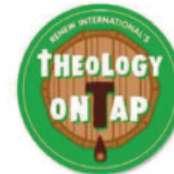
Surviving Divorce – Hope and Healing for the Catholic Family –Sundays, starting June 5th, 6:00-7:30 PM

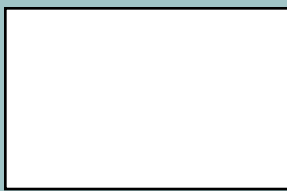

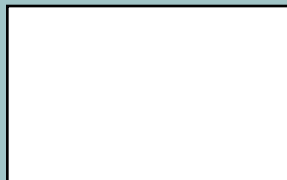
