



FR. WELDON'S CORNER

The Evangelist Luke presents to us Jesus, walking to Jerusalem, who meets some men on the road probably young men who promise they will follow him wherever he goes. Jesus proves very demanding with them and warns them that "the Son of Man", namely, the Messiah, "has nowhere to lay his head" that is to say, he has no permanent dwelling place of his own and that those who choose to work with him in God's field cannot turn back (Lk 9:57-58; 61-62). On the other hand Christ says to someone else: "Follow me", asking him to sever completely his ties with his family (Lk 9:59-60). These requirements may seem too harsh but in fact they express the newness and absolute priority of the Kingdom of God that is made present in the very Person of Jesus Christ. All things considered, it is a question of that radicalism that is due to the Love of God, whom Jesus himself was the first to obey. Those who give up everything, even themselves, to follow Jesus, enter into a new dimension of freedom that St Paul defines as "walk[ing] by the Spirit" (Gal 5:16). "For freedom Christ has set us free", the Apostle writes, and he explains that this new form of freedom acquired from Christ consists in being "servants of one another" (Gal 5:1, 13). Freedom and love coincide! On the contrary, complying with one's own egoism leads to rivalry and conflict.

El evangelista san Lucas nos presenta a Jesús que, mientras va de camino a Jerusalén, se encuentra con algunos hombres, probablemente jóvenes, que prometen seguirlo dondequiera que vaya. Con ellos se muestra muy exigente, advirtiéndoles que "el Hijo del hombre —es decir él, el Mesías— no tiene donde reclinar su cabeza", es decir, no tiene una morada estable, y que quien elige trabajar con él en el campo de Dios ya no puede dar marcha atrás (Lc 9, 57-58.61-62). A otro en cambio Cristo mismo le dice: "Sígueme", pidiéndole un corte radical con los vínculos familiares (Lc 9, 59-60). Estas exigencias pueden parecer demasiado duras, pero en realidad expresan la novedad y la prioridad absoluta del reino de Dios, que se hace presente en la Persona misma de Jesucristo. En última instancia, se trata de la radicalidad debida al Amor de Dios, al cual Jesús mismo es el primero en obedecer. Quien renuncia a todo, incluso a sí mismo, para seguir a Jesús, entra en una nueva dimensión de la libertad, que san Pablo define como "caminar según el Espíritu" (cf. Ga 5, 16). "Para ser libres nos libertó Cristo" —escribe el Apóstol— y explica que esta nueva forma de libertad que Cristo nos consiguió consiste en estar «los unos al servicio de los otros» (Ga 5, 1.13). Libertad y amor coinciden. Por el contrario, obedecer al propio egoísmo conduce a rivalidades y conflictos. Pope Benedict XVI Angelus 27 June 2010
