



FR. WELDON'S CORNER

"When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which **the laws of nature and of nature's God entitle them**, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are **endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights**, **that among these are life**, **liberty and the pursuit of happiness**. That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed."

God gave us freedom to embrace the good. American identity is grounded in law. Many people in America do not accept the Declaration, the Constitution, or any idea that exists beyond themselves. When the law is denied then there is chaos. Witness the never-ending riots and destruction in America and the increased attacks against the Catholic Church. Why do people attack a pro-life clinic that gives counseling and medical attention to a mother and her child? When the family is destroyed, each person becomes a random individual wandering about looking for an identity. Then, different powers such as government through schools, media and corporations manipulate the feelings of a child or an adult through selfishness. As faith and family identity disappears, human rights become a banner to be very selfish.

The language of the Declaration of Independence is not explicitly Christian; yet as Catholics we respect the Bill of Rights in the Constitution as they protect freedoms that make it possible to live our Catholic faith. Law must have as its foundation a greater good. The Creator is God our Father and we are brothers and sisters in and through Christ. We hold to this absolute truth. Love and truth are united. Human dignity and goodness exist because we are made in the image and likeness of God. Persons are formed in families. Faith forms the family, and this brings about a culture through education. Life in the Church is understood as the life of Grace for the faithful who have new life—freedom—in Christ. "For Freedom Christ has set us free; so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery. For you were once called for freedom, but do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh; rather, serve one another through love. For the whole law is fulfilled in one saying, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Gal 5) Let us use our freedom in Christ to do the good and be good people in this country.


