

The Apostle of the Apostles: St Mary Magdalene

The Gospels tell us that the women, unlike the Twelve, did not abandon Jesus in the hour of his Passion (cf. Mt 27: 56, 61; Mk 15: 40). Among them, Mary Magdalene stands out in particular. Not only was she present at the Passion, but she was also the first witness and herald of the Risen One (cf. Jn 20: 1, 11-18). It was precisely to Mary Magdalene that St Thomas Aquinas reserved the special title, "Apostle of the Apostles", dedicating to her this beautiful comment: "Just as a woman had announced the words of death to the first man, so also a woman was the first to announce to the Apostles the words of life". It is rather to St Paul that we are indebted for a more ample documentation on the dignity and ecclesial role of women. He begins with the fundamental principle according to which for the baptized: "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus" (Gal 3: 28), that is, all are united in the same basic dignity, although each with specific functions (cf. I Cor 12: 27: 30). The Apostle accepts as normal the fact that a woman can "prophesy" in the Christian community (I Cor 11: 5), that is, speak openly under the influence of the Spirit, as long as it is for the edification of the community and done in a dignified manner.

Los Evangelios nos informan de que las mujeres, a diferencia de los Doce, no abandonaron a Jesús en la hora de la pasión (cf. *Mt* 27, 56.61; *Mc* 15, 40). Entre estas destaca en particular la Magdalena, que no sólo estuvo presente en la Pasión, sino que se convirtió también en el primer testigo y heraldo del Resucitado (cf. *Jn* 20, 1.11-18). Precisamente a María Magdalena santo Tomás de Aquino le da el singular calificativo de "apóstol de los Apóstoles", dedicándole un bello comentario: "Del mismo modo que una mujer había anunciado al primer hombre palabras de muerte, así también una mujer fue la primera en anunciar a los Apóstoles palabras de vida". Debemos a san Pablo una documentación más amplia sobre la dignidad y el papel eclesial de la mujer. Toma como punto de partida el principio fundamental según el cual para los bautizados "ya no hay judío ni griego; ni esclavo ni libre; ni hombre ni mujer". El motivo es que "todos somos uno en Cristo Jesús" (*Ga* 3, 28), es decir, todos tenemos la misma dignidad de fondo, aunque cada uno con funciones específicas (cf. *1 Co* 12, 27-30). El Apóstol admite como algo normal que en la comunidad cristiana la mujer pueda "profetizar" (*1 Co* 11, 5), es decir, hablar abiertamente bajo el influjo del Espíritu, a condición de que sea para la edificación de la comunidad y que se haga de modo digno. 
