


FR. WELDON'S CORNER

The margin of “No” votes against the *Value them Both* amendment may have been shocking. I never expected metro KC, college towns, Wichita, and Topeka, among a few other locations, to ever vote “Yes.” I read that 19% of voters only voted regarding the amendment. Remember, Kansas was already a major location for abortions. How many Catholics voted “no” or did not vote? Abortions among professed Christians are more common than anyone cares to admit. There is a fixation on panic, fear, and false compassion and peace. People in trouble or despair make strange or tragic decisions. The battle between good and evil is real. There can be no room for naivete. The enemies of Christ and the Church are real and growing. Though our own anxieties may plague us, we must cling to Jesus and his cross. There is no gray area anymore. Either we are with Christ Jesus, or we are not. Our recent Gospels reflect the need to maintain a closeness with Christ. Martha was anxious about work and the world; the things that pass away. Mary chose the better part and sat at the foot of Jesus. The wise virgins awaited the groom with full oil lamps of prayer. So, fill your oil lamp with prayer to have a relationship with Christ Jesus. The rich farmer put his hope in never failing crops. (How crazy is that?!?) Then, he died. In today’s Gospel our Lord calls us to be alert. The heart must rest in prayer in order be vigilant and wise. The book of wisdom speaks of the righteous person having faith in God through certain knowledge of who God is. A person of faith has courage. (Wis 18) When we walk with Christ, we know who we are. “For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.”

El margen de votos "No" en contra de la enmienda *Valores Ambos* puede haber sido impactante. Nunca esperé que el metro de KC, las ciudades universitarias, Wichita y Topeka, entre algunos otros lugares, votaran "Sí". He leído que el 19% de los votantes sólo votaron con respecto a la enmienda. Recuerde, Kansas ya era un lugar importante para los abortos. ¿Cuántos católicos votaron "no" o no votaron? Los abortos entre mujeres que profesan cristiandad son más comunes de lo que a nadie le importa admitir. Hay una fijación en el pánico, el miedo y la falsa compasión y paz. Las personas en problemas o desesperación toman decisiones extrañas o trágicas. La batalla entre el bien y el mal es real. No puede haber lugar para la ingenuidad. Los enemigos de Cristo y de la Iglesia son reales y crecientes. Aunque las propias ansiedades puedan plagarnos, debes aferrarte a Jesús y a su cruz. Ya no hay zona gris. ¿Estamos con Cristo Jesús, o no? Nuestros Evangelios recientes reflejan la necesidad de mantener una cercanía con Cristo. Marta estaba ansiosa por el trabajo y el mundo; las cosas que pasan. María escogió la mejor parte y se sentó al pie de Jesús. Las vírgenes sabias esperaban al Señor con lámparas de aceite llenas de oración. Por lo tanto, llene su lámpara de aceite con oración para tener una relación con Cristo Jesús. El rico agricultor puso su esperanza en que las cosechas nunca fallaran. (¡¿Qué tan loco es eso?!?) Luego, murió. En el Evangelio de hoy, nuestro Señor nos llama a estar alerta. El corazón debe descansar en oración para estar vigilante y sabio. El libro de sabiduría habla de la persona justa que tiene fe en Dios a través de cierto conocimiento de quién es Dios. Una persona de fe tiene coraje. (Wis 18) Cuando caminamos con Cristo, sabemos quiénes somos. "Porque donde está tu tesoro, ahí estará tu corazón".




Monday, August 8th * Presentation starts at 7pm.



Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross' Story



A brilliant philosopher who stopped believing in God when she was 14, Edith Stein was so captivated by reading the autobiography of Teresa of Avila that she began a spiritual journey that led to her baptism in 1922. Twelve years later she imitated Saint Teresa by becoming a Carmelite, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross.

Born into a prominent Jewish family in Breslau, Germany—now Wroclaw, Poland—Edith abandoned Judaism in her teens. As a student at the University of Göttingen, she became fascinated by phenomenology—an approach to philosophy. Excelling as a protégé of Edmund Husserl, one of the leading phenomenologists, Edith earned a doctorate in philosophy in 1916. She continued as a university teacher until 1922, when she moved to a Dominican school in Speyer; her appointment as lecturer at the Educational Institute of Munich ended under pressure from the Nazis.

After living for four years in the Cologne Carmel, Sister Teresa Benedicta moved to the Carmelite monastery in Echt, Netherlands, in 1938. The Nazis occupied that country in 1940. In retaliation for being denounced by the Dutch bishops, the Nazis arrested all Dutch Jews who had become Christians. Teresa Benedicta and her sister Rosa, also a Catholic, died in a gas chamber in Auschwitz on August 9, 1942.

Pope John Paul II beatified Teresa Benedicta of the Cross in 1987 and canonized her 12 years later.
