The big journey of life is to trust that God will take care of us. Making a pilgrimage of any kind is a Catholic way of praying with the body—every step—to reach a holy destination. I started the Fr. Kapaun pilgrimage in 2009, primarily as a way to purify and trust in Jesus. One of the most popular pilgrimages in the history of the Church is the “El Camino Real de Santiago del Compostela.” Around 814 AD, King Alfonso II of Galicia made a pilgrimage to Compostela to reverence the bones of St. James (Santiago). Earlier this year, Al Jirak of Sacred Heart Parish in Colwich called me to join a group of fathers and sons to walk the Camino. We walked two legs of the French route of the Camino Real in northern Spain: about 135 miles at 13 to 17 miles per day. Ascending a trail was brutal. Descending a trail was easy on the breathing but the rocks bruised our feet. I received many blessings being with good Catholic fathers and sons and meeting a wide variety of people. The geography was beautiful and I enjoyed seeing old churches and chapels dating to the 12th century. It was exhausting physically, emotionally, and spiritually, and always in that order. The physical exhaustion draws out the emotions and the reality of one's weakness and the need to rely on God. Our yoke is weakness, and the yoke of Christ is light. (Mt 11: 28-30) It was a big step to be gone from the parish for 3 Sundays. Please know that during the journey I prayed for the parish and for many specific intentions. Thank you so much for your patience and prayers.

Santiago de Compostela

El gran viaje de la vida es confiar en que Dios cuidará de nosotros. Hacer una peregrinación de cualquier tipo es una forma católica de orar con el cuerpo—a cada paso—para llegar a un destino santo. Comencé la peregrinación del P. Kapaun en 2009, principalmente como una forma de purificar y confiar en Jesús. Una de las peregrinaciones más populares en la historia de la Iglesia es el “Camino Real de Santiago del Compostela.” Alrededor del año 814 d.C., el rey Alfonso II de Galicia hizo una peregrinación a Compostela para reverenciar los huesos de Santiago. A principios de este año, Al Jirak de la Parroquia del Sagrado Corazón en Colwich me llamó para unirme a un grupo de padres e hijos para caminar el Camino. Caminamos dos etapas de la ruta francesa del Camino Real en el norte de España: unas 135 millas a 13 a 17 millas por día. Ascender por un sendero fue brutal. Descender por un sendero fue fácil para respirar, pero las rocas nos magullaron los pies. Recibí muchas bendiciones estando con buenos padres e hijos católicos y conociendo a una gran variedad de personas. La geografía era hermosa y disfruté viendo antiguas iglesias y capillas que datan del siglo XII. Era agotador física, emocional y espiritualmente, y siempre en ese orden. El agotamiento físico saca a relucir las emociones y la realidad de la propia debilidad y la necesidad de confiar en Dios. Nuestro yugo es debilidad, y el yugo de Cristo es luz. (Mt 11, 28-30) Sepan que durante el viaje recé por la parroquia y por muchas intenciones específicas. Fue un gran paso estar fuera de la parroquia durante 3 domingos. Sidewalk Advocates for Life Training

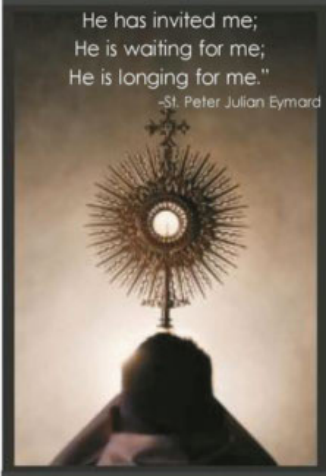
