

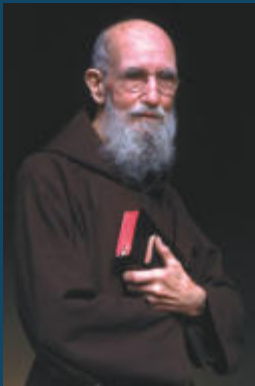

SUNDAY'S READINGS

First Reading: The prophet Ezekiel is presented as the Lord's "sentinel," announcing both God's salvation and judgment. If you warn the wicked, trying to turn him from his way, and he refuses to turn from his way, he shall die for his guilt, but you shall save yourself. (Ez 33:9)

Psalm: If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts. (Ps 95)

Second Reading: Paul argues that "love is the fulfillment of the Law." Whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Rom 13:9a)

Gospel: Jesus challenges his disciples to confront sin directly, even when it occurs with those closest to you. "If two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father." (Mt 18:19) ©LPi

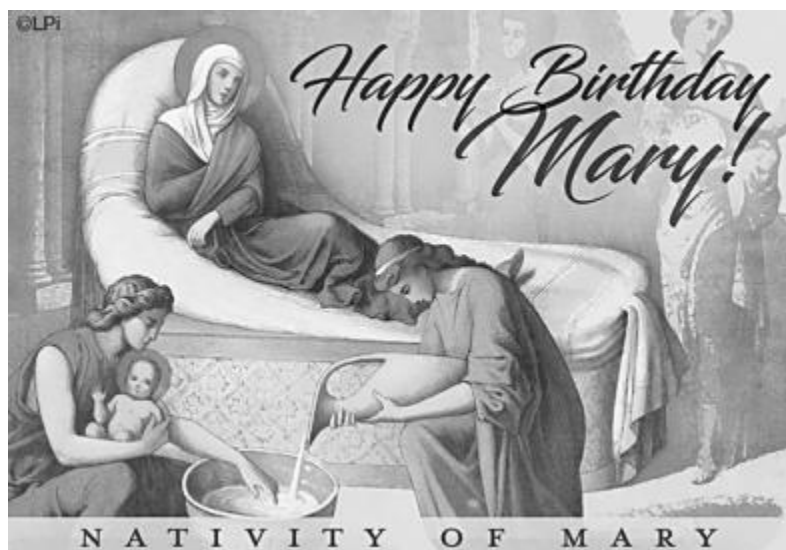
The Blessing of the Community
