## Rejoice! Christ is risen!

Welcome to all who celebrate with us this Easter weekend, and in particular, welcome and congratulations to our newest St Mary Parish family members – those joining the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil and those who've joined the parish this year (see page 2 for their names and pictures, and be sure to say hi and welcome them)!

"The grace contained in the Sacraments of Easter (Baptism and Communion) is an enormous potential for the renewal of our personal existence, of family life, of social relations," said Pope Francis. "However everything passes through the human heart: if I let myself be touched by the grace of the Risen Christ, if I let him change me in that aspect of mine which is not good, which can hurt me and others, I allow the victory of Christ to be affirmed in my life, to broaden its beneficial action."

Our parish life is enriched and renewed by the grace of the Risen Christ, by new members, and by those that have been parishioners for years (some for their entire lives).

Together – young, old, middle-aged – we help each other grow spiritually, lift one another up when we are down, and celebrate with great joy the Eucharist, the sacraments, and other milestones.

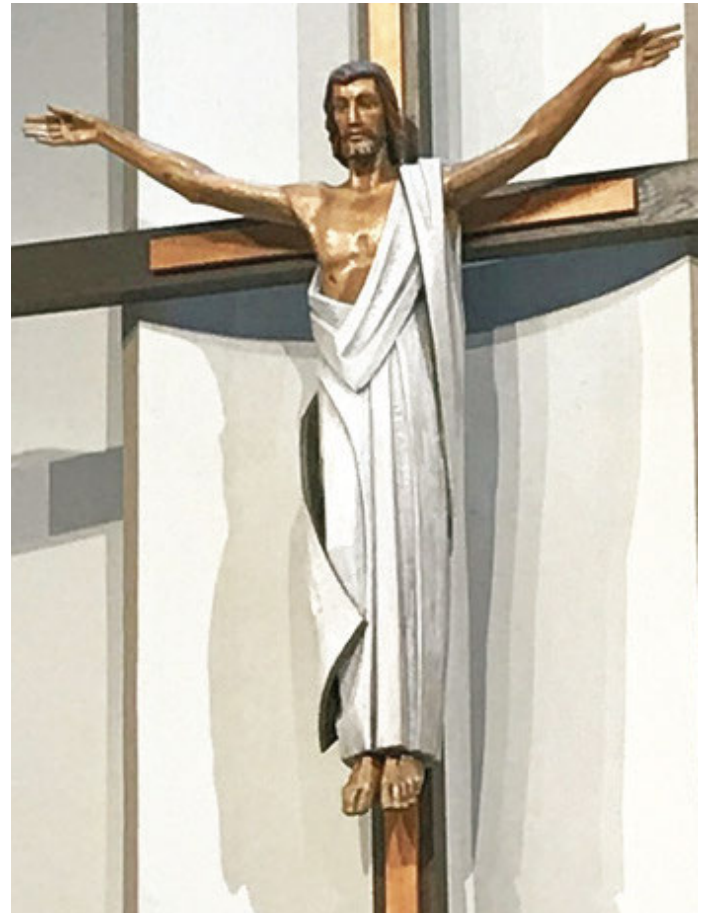
Next weekend we are having a parish celebration dinner to recognize two things – what a great parish community we have, and that we are paying off the parish loan on the school this month.

Our last really big parish celebration was in 2004, our 50th anniversary as a parish. While some of you were parishioners then and might remember it, many were not. In future bulletins we'll include more photos and your comments on your dinner RSVP cards about why you love our parish, but there wasn't enough space in this Messenger!

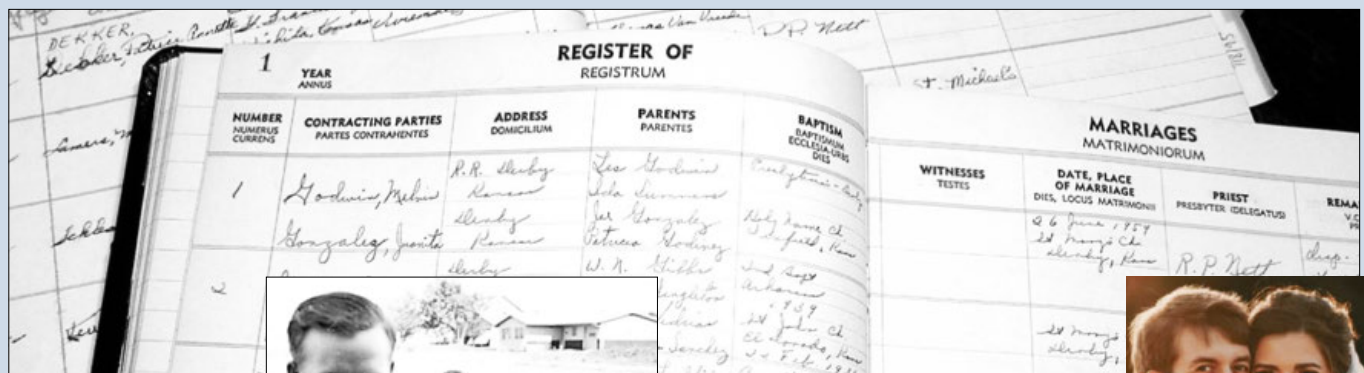

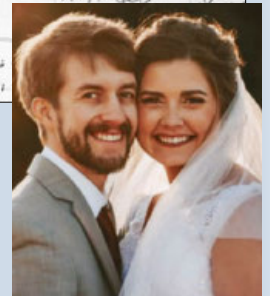

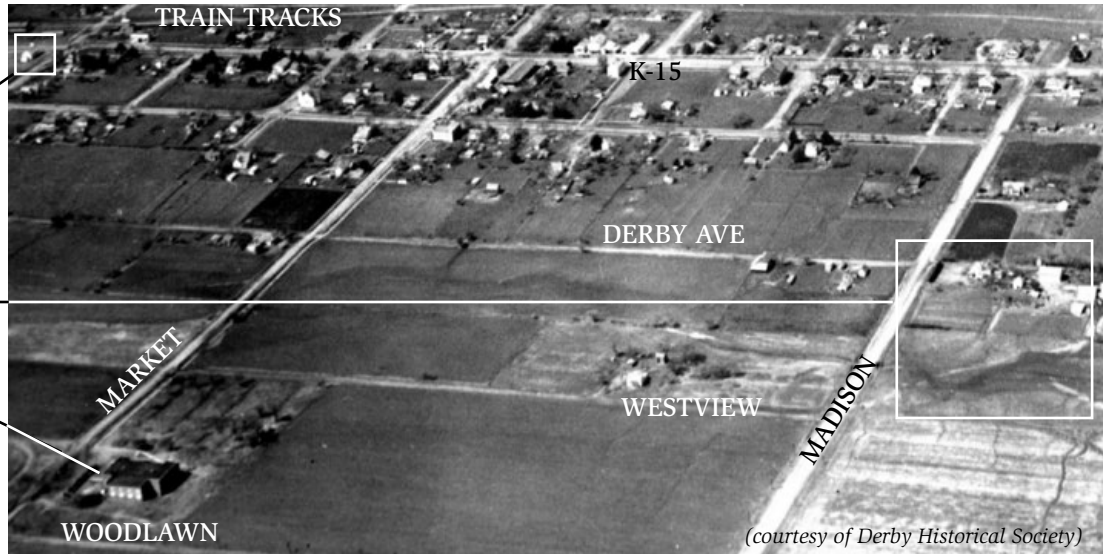

Our parish site from 1954-2011, with farmhouse that was used as a convent at first. The site is now Madison Ave. Central Park

- 1882..... Mission church established in El Paso/Derby with 12 families
- 1887..... Diocese of Wichita established
- 1890s..... Altar and Rosary Society formed
- 1882-1954 Mission served by visiting priests from Burns, Newton, Wichita, Mulvane
- 1953..... Land purchased for parish plant; construction began in October
- 1954..... Full parish status decreed February 1, with 40 families**  
 Father Roland Nett named pastor, Father Hugh O'Keefe assistant  
 St Mary Catholic School opened doors in September,  
 Sister Beatrice Boecker principal  
 Chapel, school complex (\$90,000 building) dedicated by Bishop Carroll  
 Catechism for parish children attending public schools established
- 1955..... Parish grew to 225 families  
 Father Neil Diver named new pastor  
 School hot lunch program began, Mary Jones director
- 1957..... Parish population reached 330 families  
 Father Francis Baumstark named pastor  
 Chapel area moved into Social Hall to allow for more classrooms.  
 Social Hall used for chapel, hot lunch & recreation  
 Cornerstone laid for current church (\$120,000 building) in October  
 Knights of Columbus Council 4458 established in July,  
 with 44 charter members  
 St Mary Credit Union established
- 1958..... First Eighth Grade Graduation Class, Jerry Fager, et al  
 New church dedicated by Bishop Carroll in April  
 Fr Charles Harvey named assist. pastor; Principal Terrence Gronniger, CSJ
- 1960..... Principal Wilma Korphage, CSJ
- 1961..... Principal Kathleen Regan, CSJ
- 1962..... Rectory completed in April
- 1963..... Convent completed in November
- 1968..... Father James Wilkinson named as new pastor  
 First Parish Council, first school board  
 Knights of Columbus purchased Columbian Acres  
 Fr Dennis Ryan named assist. pastor, Sr Julita Paulie, CSJ named principal
- 1969..... New order of the Mass emphasizing communal aspect of Eucharist,  
 active participation of assembly in liturgy
- 1971..... Principal Zita Oberle, CSJ
- 1974..... Father Robert Watson, new pastor and Principal Thomasine Driver, CSJ  
 Church interior remodeled
- 1977..... Principal Mary Jane Boher, CSJ
- 1979..... Father Arthur Busch named pastor  
 School Board and Finance Committee established  
 Parish now 750 families, debt-free thanks to hard work of parishioners, bingo and credit union
- 1979..... 25th Anniversary of parish celebrated**

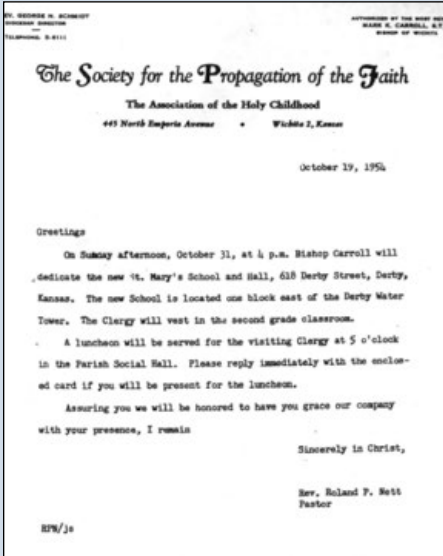

*Bishop Mark Carroll (pictured with Father Nett, St Mary's first pastor) presided at the dedication of the new chapel and school complex on October 31, 1954.*



Current parishioners Gary Jarchow and Rene Kilian located and made copies of the title documents for the former dairy farm purchased in March 1953. The view at right is looking due west. On the right hand side is the south side of the school before the Parish Center and connecting tunnel were built. On the left hand side where the crowd is gathered is the farm building that was used by the sisters as a convent for a couple of years. Altar Society cleaned it for them and made dinners for the sisters.



The windows pictured at left are the faculty lounge and Ms. Parks' kindergarten classroom in 2004; the stairs then led from the staff lounge to the tunnel and the sidewalk curved back to the playground.

The new chapel dedicated in 1954 was located where the middle school classrooms were in 2004, on the lower level of the school building. The windows were on the east side, facing the playground. The original cross and tabernacle from the chapel are still used today, although the tabernacle had a cupola added to the top during the intervening years, and the cross is now in the confessional. Autumn Auction started as community builder and building fundraiser
- 1983.... Groundbreaking for new Activity Center, attended by Bishop Eugene Gerber
- 1984.... Parish Center completed
- 1985.... Principal Margaret Nugent, CSJ
- 1986.... Father H Patrick Malone pastor, Fathers Robert Spencer and Robert Palacios assistant pastors  
New focus in Diocese and at St Mary on lay involvement in leadership
- 1986-92 United Catholic Stewardship instilled into parish life  
Religious education upgraded and expanded under Directors of Religious Education Sister Dorothy Jean Griffin, CSJ, Jeannette Trimmell, ASC, Janice Grochowsky, CSJ and Kathy Stuhlsatz
- 1987.... 100th Anniversary of the Wichita Diocese  
Autumn Auction became Community Benefit Auction
- 1988.... First parish newsletter, "Manna for the People"  
Stewardship of Treasure doubled
- 1988.... Diocese introduced new approach to leadership, focusing on ministry (e.g., liturgy); Pastoral Council formed
- 1989.... Principal Charles Monckton
- 1992.... Father H Jay Setter pastor, Father Jose Machado assistant  
School expanded, adding second class in some grades  
Liturgical environment emphasized and enriched; girls ministered as altar servers
- 1994.... Parish newsletter revived as St Mary Messenger  
St Mary Parish School named Banner School for Diocese  
All School Reunion and 40th Anniversary Celebration
- 1995-98. Expanded classes withdrawn due to financial constraints  
Pastoral Council recommended expanding or building new facilities; *Freeing the Spirit building campaign* began  
Father H introduced Life Rap for teens in PSR, CYO expanded, Janet Clark Director of Religious Education
- 1998-2003 Father Wayne Schmid new pastor; Marie Zogelman, ASC, pastoral associate, liturgist, RCIA director  
Pastoral Evaluation Project, parish census, needs and facilities assessments, financial feasibility study  
Parish leadership organized into the Pastoral Council of Ministries  
Kathy Parisio Bookkeeper; Principal Richard Montgomery; new staff positions created to accomodate the demands of a growing parish: Director of Stewardship and Development Andrea Eastman, Director of Communications Davi Stuhlsatz, Liturgical Musician Brenda Pickett, Membership Coordinator Pam Bigge  
Parish website developed  
Convent converted to preschool and annex, rectory converted to parish offices/meeting space,  
New residence purchased for pastor
- 2000.... Parish said yes to the proposal to build new facilities at Columbian Acres site  
Repitching the Tent Committees formed, Master Plan developed  
Focused on increasing Stewardship  
Started offering Preschool. Started as morning only with Marcia Helten; expanded to afternoons & full days later
- 2001.... Presentation of Master Plan and renderings to parish  
LIFE TEEN high school youth ministry & faith formation program introduced; Preschool opened  
Diocese expanded parish boundaries to include Rose Hill  
Bishop Eugene Gerber retired
- 2002.... Stewardship Mosaic unveiled in February, annual Parish Walk, symbolic of journey of faith, initiated in April  
The EDGE middle school youth ministry & faith formation program introduced
- 2003.... St Mary received national recognition, the Archbishop Thomas J. Murphy Award for Stewardship  
St Mary Parish School received academic Standard of Excellence on all eight state assessments taken
- 2004.... **50th Anniversary of parish celebrated with breakfast, dinner/dance, banner** *(timeline cont. on page 8)*

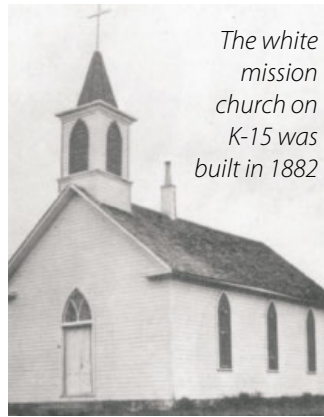
# Thank you!

- 2018... Parish Listening Session
