
Next weekend we are having a parish celebration dinner to recognize two things – what a great parish community we have, and that we are paying off the parish loan on the school this month.





# 1954: Becoming a parish, and building at the corner of Derby & Madison Ave.



Bishop Mark Carroll (pictured with Father Nett, St Mary's first pastor) presided at the dedication of the new chapel and school complex on October 31, 1954.



Current parishioners Gary Jarchow and Rene Kilian located and made copies of the title documents for the former dairy farm purchased in March 1953. The view at right is looking due west. On the right hand side is the south side of the school before the Parish Center and connecting tunnel were built. On the left hand side where the crowd is gathered is the farm building that was used by the sisters as a convent for a couple of years. Altar Society cleaned it for them and made dinners for the sisters.



The windows pictured at left are the faculty lounge and Ms. Parks' kindergarten classroom in 2004; the stairs then led from the staff lounge to the tunnel and the sidewalk curved back to the playground.

The new chapel dedicated in 1954 was located where the middle school classrooms were in 2004, on the lower level of the school building. The windows were on the east side, facing the playground. The original cross and tabernacle from the chapel are still used today, although the tabernacle had a cupola added to the top during the intervening years, and the cross is now in the confessional.
