Clergy Corner

This week on Tuesday, the Church begins a week of prayer dedicated to Christian Unity. The great multiplicity of Christian denominations is a deep wound in the Body of Christ. Jesus himself desires the complete union of all Christians in one flock under one shepherd: "that they all may be one" - cf. John 17:21-23. While maintaining that the Catholic Church faithfully and without error hands on the fullness of the revelation of Jesus Christ, it cannot be denied that at times we have been obstacles to this unity desired by Christ. This happens whenever we fail to give a true Christian witness by the way we live our lives. It is one thing to be a sinner and to acknowledge our weakness and the need we all have for God's mercy. It is quite a different thing when we profess one creed in church on Sunday and live the rest of the week as if we followed a different one. All the more is the great need that we live our lives faithfully to the calling we have received in the Church. To that end, here are three simple ways of fostering a spirit of Christian Unity.

- Learn more about the teachings of the Catholic Church. In my own experience, it seems that many times disagreements between Christians stem from a lack of understanding on both sides. The more we know about the teachings of our Church the less likely we will fall into disagreements about things that are misunderstood. A good resource to learning more about your faith is the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
- Engage in fruitful dialogue with those of other faiths. It is good to not be afraid to talk to others about the teachings of their faith, if they are open to discussing it. This helps us to grow in mutual understanding and can challenge us as Catholics to go deeper in our own understanding of why we believe what we believe.
- 3. Pray for the union of all Christians. We will never be truly united by ignoring our differences, it will only come about by reconciliation made possible by the Holy Spirit. To this end we pray that all Christians may be gathered into the one fold of Christ again.

Volunteers Needed

As a parish family, we are all called to not only come to Masses, but to share our time, talent, and treasure to enable our parish to minister to our people. 


Valentyna Pavsyukova to Speak via Live Stream




