Prayer: God is thirsting for us

"If you knew the gift of God!" The wonder of prayer is revealed beside the well where we come seeking water: there, Christ comes to meet every human being. It is he who first seeks us and asks us for a drink. Jesus thirsts; his asking arises from the depths of God's desire for us. Whether we realize it or not, prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for him." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2560)

Throughout the Lenten season, we have been called to grow in our prayer to the Lord. Many times, however, the practice of prayer can start to seem like just one more thing I have to get done throughout my day. Prayer can quickly become associated with a work to get done and it can start to feel like a burden when that happens. But as the above quote from the Catechism reminds us, prayer is ultimately an encounter with the living God who thirsts for us. God, though He lacks nothing, desires in an abundance of His love to be in communion with us. If prayer has started to become a burden in your own life, a good practice is to begin with this meditation. Before beginning any time of prayer, first start by quieting your mind for a few moments and then put yourself into the presence of Jesus. Recall to your mind that Jesus is thirsting for your soul, that He is desiring this time of prayer even more than you. Picture in your own mind His face, how he might be looking at you as you look to Him.

This little meditation before prayer should only last a few moments before you begin your usual prayer routine, but it does help to put you into the right mindset. It reminds us that our prayer should be an encounter with a real and living person, not an abstraction, nor a simple list of things we say each day. We are encountering the Living God each time we raise our minds to heaven and are satisfying not only our own souls in the process, but in a real way are giving drink to a God who thirsts for us.

Continue to persevere in your prayer throughout this Lenten season. Please pray for me and I'll pray for you. -Fr. Reither


