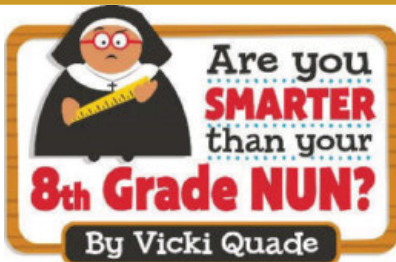

## FROM THE PASTOR

The image of the mustard seed is as important for us today as it was nineteen hundred years ago. It alerts us to one of the ways God fosters the Kingdom – very slowly, without fanfare. When we remember this, we are more likely to cooperate with and facilitate the patient process. When we ignore it, we are likely to get in the way and hinder the Kingdom.

One example.....among many.....come to mind right away. I think of the difficulty people have when struggling with addictions ....to alcohol, drugs, gambling, eating, pornography or other sexual excesses, etc, etc. One of my invitations as a priest is to remember the mustard seed when such persons come to me seeking God’s help, insight, encouragement, .....whether in counseling situations or in confession. They want to change desperately, they know how destructive their behavior is to themselves and others whom they love; and yet the addictions continue, regardless of their best intentions, their best efforts.

Jesus’ message today of the mustard seed is so helpful at those times. How they need to hear it, whether I refer to the precise image or not. The Kingdom of God is coming to fruition in them slowly, patiently, perhaps imperceptibly, because that’s the truth of Jesus’ teaching today. If they want to see the blossoming right away, they can so easily become discouraged and give up. “The mustard seed” ....the Kingdom of God is like “mustard seed.” Slow growing, but eventually embracing all....the good!...and the bad and the ugly. We all belong in the Kingdom of God and we need to place our trust and hope in Jesus’ words to be determined, to be steady, and to be patient, about overcoming our weaknesses and our sinfulness.

Jesus says the mustard seed “becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the “birds” of the sky can dwell in its shade.” In such tender metaphor, Jesus is telling us that the Kingdom of God is meant to include all kinds of people (all species of birds), Jew and Greek, free and slave, rich and poor, saint and sinner. We are blessed to have a patient God! -Msgr. Greg

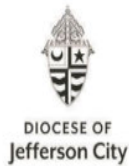

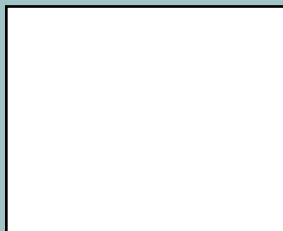
