Greetings,

One of the greatest parish priests of all time was nearly not ordained. This 19th century priest struggled greatly with his seminary schooling but through the help of Latin tutors he was finally accepted for ordination by his bishop.

St. John Vianney was born in France in 1786 to a family who had kept their faith firmly in spite of the intense anti-Catholic persecution that took place in his day. His desire to become a priest was nearly blocked by his being drafted into Napoleon's army, then by academic struggles, and finally by a large group of people who tried to run him out of town.

Ordained in 1815 he was eventually sent to a little village called Ars. The people had very little interest in God and were very attached to a variety of sins. St. John, though simple as he was, gave himself totally to his mission which was and still is the glorification of God and the sanctification of the Christian people.

Eventually there were 100,000 pilgrims piling into the tiny village of Ars every year. St. John would hear confessions for up to 18 hours a day to the tune of 75,000 confessions a year. Sometimes the pilgrims would wait a week just to go to confession to the great saint.

It is said that the devil once accused St John of stealing 80,000 souls from him. And for this, the devil regularly tried to punish this holy priest. Satan would get bucky in the day's leading up to some major conversions that were in the process of taking place the following day. He heavily harassed the holy priest in various ways to no effect. He even started St. John's bed on fire; the results of which can still be seen to this day.

"Pope John XXIII called St. John a 'model of priestly life and pastoral zeal which helped accomplish such dramatic results rarely seen in history.' A true ascetic, Vianney often fasted on a few potatoes a day and prayed sometimes through the night for the conversion of his parish." (Franciscan Media)

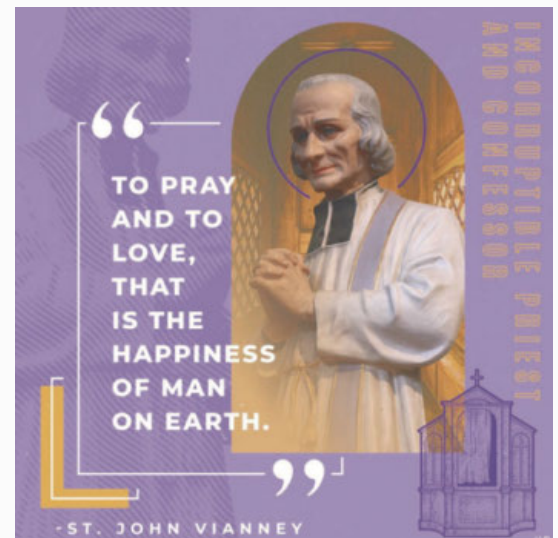
We should all be praying for our shepherds that through the intercession of St. John Vianney they may be holy and effective ministers of God's grace.

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Thank you to everyone who attended the All Things New Listening Session on Wednesday, July 23, 2025. We received comprehensive and valuable feedback and are gathering all the information to accurately respond to your questions. Below are the questions for the week. We also encourage you to submit the survey included in last week's bulletin and distributed at the meeting last week, or contact an All Things New Committee member.

Something to Ponder: The differences between "Parishes" and "Churches." The parish is a group of people. The church is the building where the people meet.

Define Primary and Partner Church? What constitutes a primary church and what constitutes a partner church? A Primary Church is used for all weekend liturgies and holy days. A Partner Church is used for all weekend liturgies but not holy days.

Are we one or two ACCs? We are one ACC with two Pastors and seven parishes.

Do you need any more help on the ACC Council? Thank you for the offer of additional assistance. We currently have enough representation from the parishes in the ACC. However, if it is determined that additional assistance is needed, the Pastors will reach out to parishioners.

Committee, Priests or Bishops....Who ultimately makes the decision of the ACC in the end? The Bishop will ultimately make the decision. The ACC All Things New Committee is responsible for listening to parishioners, prayerfully evaluating all the feedback and information, and making recommendations to the Bishop.

Has the Bishop approved the recommendations set forth by the planning council. Could there be more recommendations coming? (Are the "Bullet" points in the previous bulletin suggestions or are they fully approved by the Bishop? The Bishop has approved all the parameters provided by the Diocesan office to the All Things New Committees in each Diocese of St. Cloud Area Catholic Community. There are no additional parameters coming from the Diocese.

What was the population in the ACC in 2010 versus now? The data below is a survey independently completed by Mission Insite. This data is for our ACC only.

The Committee's Purpose statement is: *The All Things New ACC Planning Committee is committed to developing a comprehensive plan for the ACC that fosters a vibrant faith community rooted in the love and mission of Jesus and in line with the diocesan parameters provided. The committee will work in collaboration with the Planning Facilitator Team, diocesan staff, and ACC community members, guided by the Holy Spirit, to create a strategic, future-oriented plan.*

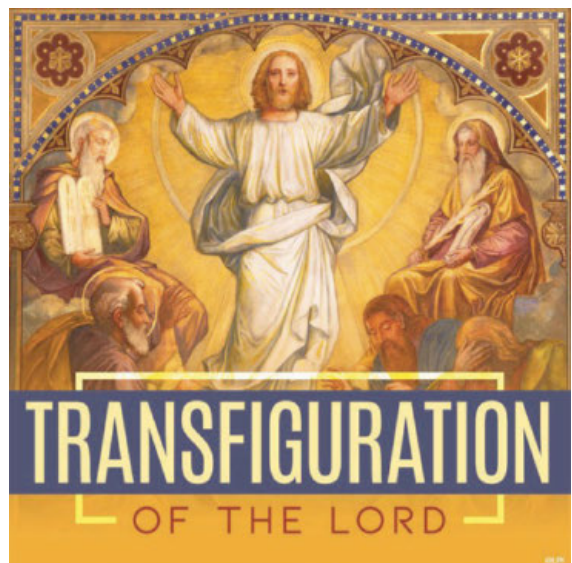

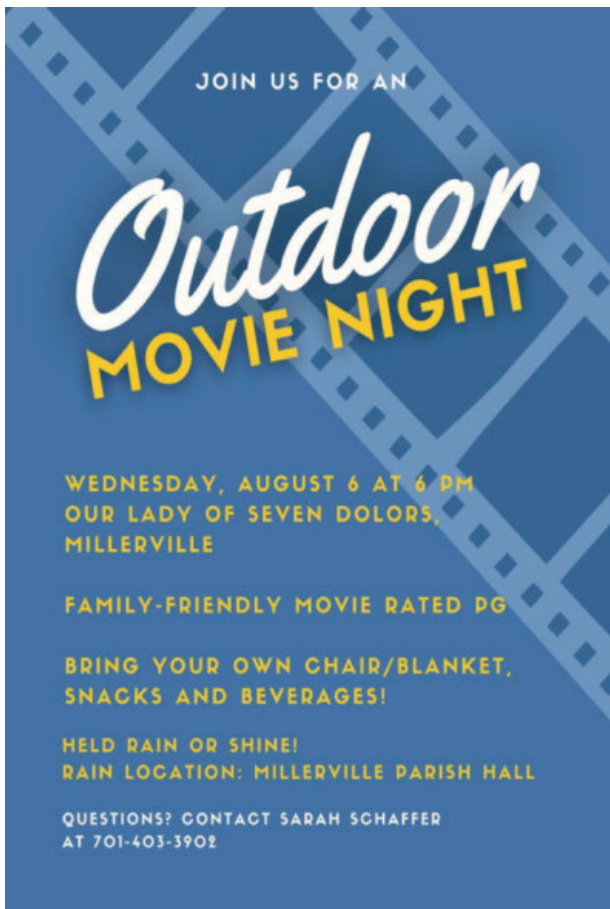
St. Cloud Diocesan Council of Catholic Women:

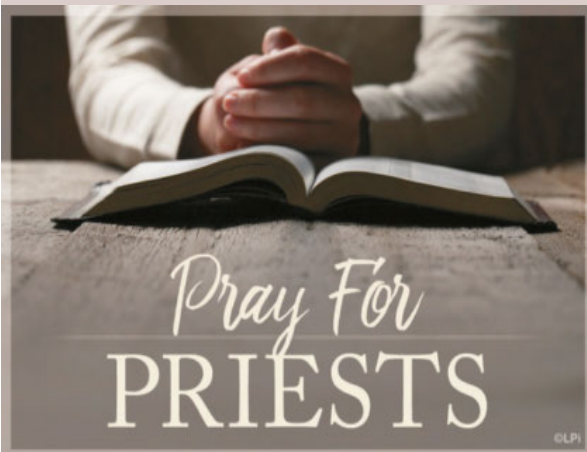
