# COMMUNITY IN FAITH

## HOPE

When I think about what it means to have hope, specifically while in the “desert”, the saying “light at the end of the tunnel” comes to mind.

According to paragraph 1818 of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, “The Virtue of hope responds to the aspiration to happiness which God has placed in the heart of every man; it takes up the hopes that inspire men’s activities and purifies them so as to order them to the Kingdom of heaven; it keeps man from discouragement; it sustains him during times of abandonment; it opens up his heart in expectation of eternal beatitude.”.

One could say, that hope points us towards the light at the end of the tunnel – the Kingdom of heaven. But the reality is that the Kingdom of heaven isn’t just at the end of the tunnel. It is also here and now. And we experience it every time we come together with our brothers and sisters for the Eucharistic feast, when we enter God’s time being joined as one with the past, the present and the future.

So, the question to ask ourselves is, do we dare to have hope while we are in the desert? Abraham certainly did and he was asked to make a much greater sacrifice than most of us will ever be asked to make. “He believed, hoping against hope, that he would become ‘the father of many nations’...” (Romans 4:18). Let us all strive to be like Abraham in our faith, hope and trust in God our Father.

Speaking of having faith, hope, and trust... next year we will be transitioning our RE program into a more traditional program. We will be utilizing resources from RCL Benziger: “*Stories of God’s Love*” (3-year-olds – Kindergarten) and “*Blest Are We: Faith in Action*” (1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>). “*Edge*” will continue to serve our 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> graders and “*Life Teen*” will continue to serve our 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders.

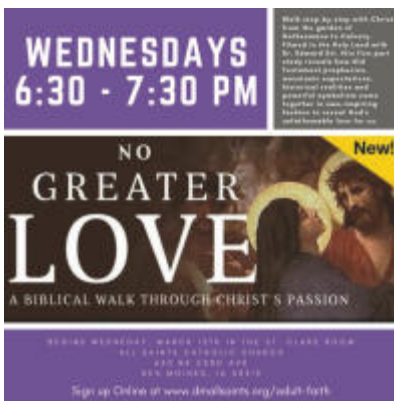
I am very excited for these new resources! They will offer our parish community many opportunities to grow together in faith. These resources offer beautifully illustrated bible stories, practical life examples of how to apply our faith into our daily lives and we will incorporate some of our existing materials as hands on opportunities for our children to enter further into their weekly lessons. We will also offer monthly Mass, Reconciliation, and Adoration for our children and teens. Our students will have opportunities to learn about the liturgy as they prepare for their Student Led Masses, where they will take up various roles within the Mass itself. It is my sincere hope that this new program will continue to offer our children opportunities to form a relationship with Christ. And that it will continue to inspire our families to grow together and live their faith boldly.

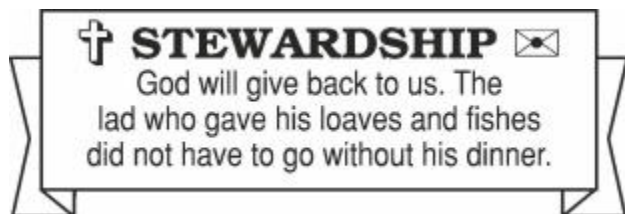

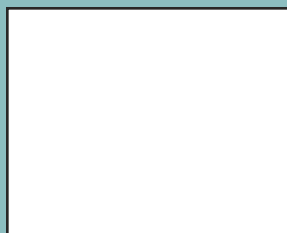

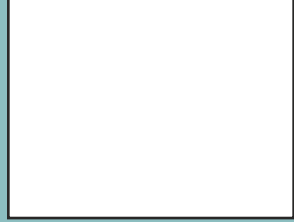
