REFLECTION

The Gospel features two short parables and sheep gates in which Jesus draws on the imagery of shepherding in the ancient world. The first contrasts the good shepherd with a thief or a stranger. We are to imagine a large corral where the sheep are kept safe from wild animals when they are not in the field at pasture. Unlike a thief or stranger, the good shepherd enters through the gate, calls his sheep by name, and leads them out.

As followers of Jesus, we recognize that the gate swings in two directions. We come into the sheep fold through him, and we are led out through him. As we are led in through Jesus, we find a place of refreshment and resting the embrace of the believing community. A space where our wounds can be healed and where we can be nourished by the word and at the table.

Reflect on the words of these Scriptures in light of your own desire for full and abundant life.

PAVEMENT AND EROSION

Due to significant pavement and erosion issues with our entire parking lot and surrounding areas, we have hired Olsson Engineering to seek bids to remedy these problems. Due to our limited Capital Campaign funds originally identified for these issues, we will need to schedule this project in four phases, as it will cost approximately \$150,000. If you have not met your Capital Campaign pledge yet, please do so. Any additional funds applied toward our Capital Campaign balance of approximately \$50,000 is gratefully appreciated.

Olsson Engineering is starting work, May through July, with our parking lot pavement and surrounding erosion issues. Please do not pick up any flags or square black and white markers on the property that will be used for utility markings and drone aerial views taken. Thank you.
