FOOD PANTRY

A big "thank you" goes out to all the parishioners who donate to the Catholic Charities Food Pantry! The cash donations are used to buy fresh produce, dairy products, and toiletries (over \$1,600 in the last six months) and occasionally help out with special needs. Recently, the 87th street location acquired a double door upright commercial size freezer that St. Pius was asked to help fill, and that we did - 625lbs. of a variety of chicken, pork, turkey, and beef products were purchased! Also, our shelves at the church are filled every month with nonperishable food items that are taken to the Food Pantry, donated by the always generous St. Pius X parishioners - 2170 lbs. in six months. Your generosity "feeds the hungry"- people in need right here, our neighbors.
