## CAMPAIGN/REMODEL UPDATE!

Well, as usual, things are moving along at a pretty good pace. The bathrooms have been demolished and they are putting in the wider openings and doing the mechanical. Constructions of the closets in classrooms are framed in.

Hopefully, by the time you read this the new HVAC will have been installed in the office. At this writing, I am staying cool in the Parish Meeting room.

The pews in the church have been reinstalled. The forms for the acoustical pads and the covers from the organ speakers have been removed and recovered.

The tile work on the altar and choir platforms (not part of the capital campaign projects) will begin this week. We need to shore up the surface and put down concrete board so hopefully we can be done with the tiles popping all the time.

A security fence has been put up around the 55th Street wing and demolition is set for August 5.

The campaign is going well. So far \$923,000 has been pledged and \$360,000 of that has been collected. We are so grateful for your love and support of St. Pius Parish. We are hopeful that all projects will be completed by the end of November and that we will be back in the church by the end of August.

We do have a special request. Since the capital projects will be completed before all the money from the capital campaign is completed, we'd like to ask, if you are in a position to do so, if you could pay your commitment early to help us avoid taking out a short term loan?

Thank you again for your support. Truly, SPX is God's "Green Acre".
