

#### A Message from Father David

I will be going to Los Angeles, CA for a retreat with my very favorite Order of Religious Women: The Carmelite Sisters of the Sacred Heart Los Angeles. The date for my departure is February 14<sup>th</sup> and my return is on February 24<sup>th</sup>. On the weekend of February 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> I am even more pleased to announce that Bishop Daniel Felton (The Bishop of the Diocese of Duluth, MN) will be making a Parish visit and saying Mass at both Holy Family in McGregor and St. James in Aitkin with the normal Mass times that weekend. While there in CA I am going to do an 8-day Ignatian Retreat to prepare myself for a 30-Day Silent Ignatian; in most retreat centers the 8-day is a prerequisite for signing up for the 30-day. Wanting to do the 30-day has long been a desire of mine and I'm not sure when I'll be able to fit it in; someday, I hope. Pray that my flights work out to LA. There is an indoor mask mandate at the convent and retreat center and quite possibly all of California (not sure). The hardest part is the flight and waiting in the airport, that's a long time to be masked up. Oh well, the old

Catholic "offer-it-up" for the salvation of souls works out pretty handy in situations like that. I'm just pleased I can finally go on a retreat, it's been over 2½ years. For inquiring minds about the United Catholic Appeal and how our parishes met each goal: St. James in Aitkin met its goal and had a carryover for next year of \$37.56; Our Lady of Fatima in McGrath met its goal and had a carryover for next year of \$75.19; Holy Family in McGregor did not meet its goal and had a shortfall of \$3,905.36 which came out of its ordinary income. This is an improvement from previous years' more significant shortfalls, so that is good, making progress.

I would like to thank all the people who helped with the funerals for Westin Justen and Isaac Fulton. We had over 500+ people at the Candlelight Vigil 400+ people at Westin's funeral and 200+ people at Isaac's funeral. All of these required extra help and the CCW and K of C's really stepped up. I want to thank Aggie Lacore for a lot of the behind the scenes work and Becky Joerger as well. God bless all of you. Please continue to pray for the Justen and Fulton families.
