



Celebrating Christ



Christmas Envelopes

Stock Contributions

Appreciated stock is a great way to make a contribution AND perhaps maximize your tax benefit. Stocks must be transferred by December 31st for credit in tax year 2021.

Employer Matching Funds

Check with your employer to determine whether a matching gift from your company can double the value of a contribution to St. John the Baptist Catholic Church or Montessori School.

IRA Charitable Deduction

Individuals who are 70 and a half or older may direct distributions from their traditional IRA to eligible charitable organizations. The provision has a cap of \$100,000 for charitable distributions from individual IRAs each year. Individuals may exclude the amount distributed directly to an eligible charity from their gross income. The tax incentive regarding IRA contributions provides a marvelous gift opportunity for senior parishioners owning IRA's. Please consider a direct IRA distribution to St. John's!

Establishing a Donor Advised Fund through Catholic Community Foundation can offer immediate tax benefits today while ensuring your ability to give to St. John the Baptist Catholic Parish in an on-going manner for years to come. Please note that the IRS requires that gifts must be **postmarked** or **received** into the parish office by Dec. 31st in order to qualify for a 2021 deduction. Envelopes placed in the collection basket or delivered to the church by Friday, December 31st will count towards 2021 giving, while those placed in the collection on Saturday, January 1st and forward will count towards 2022 giving, regardless of check date.
