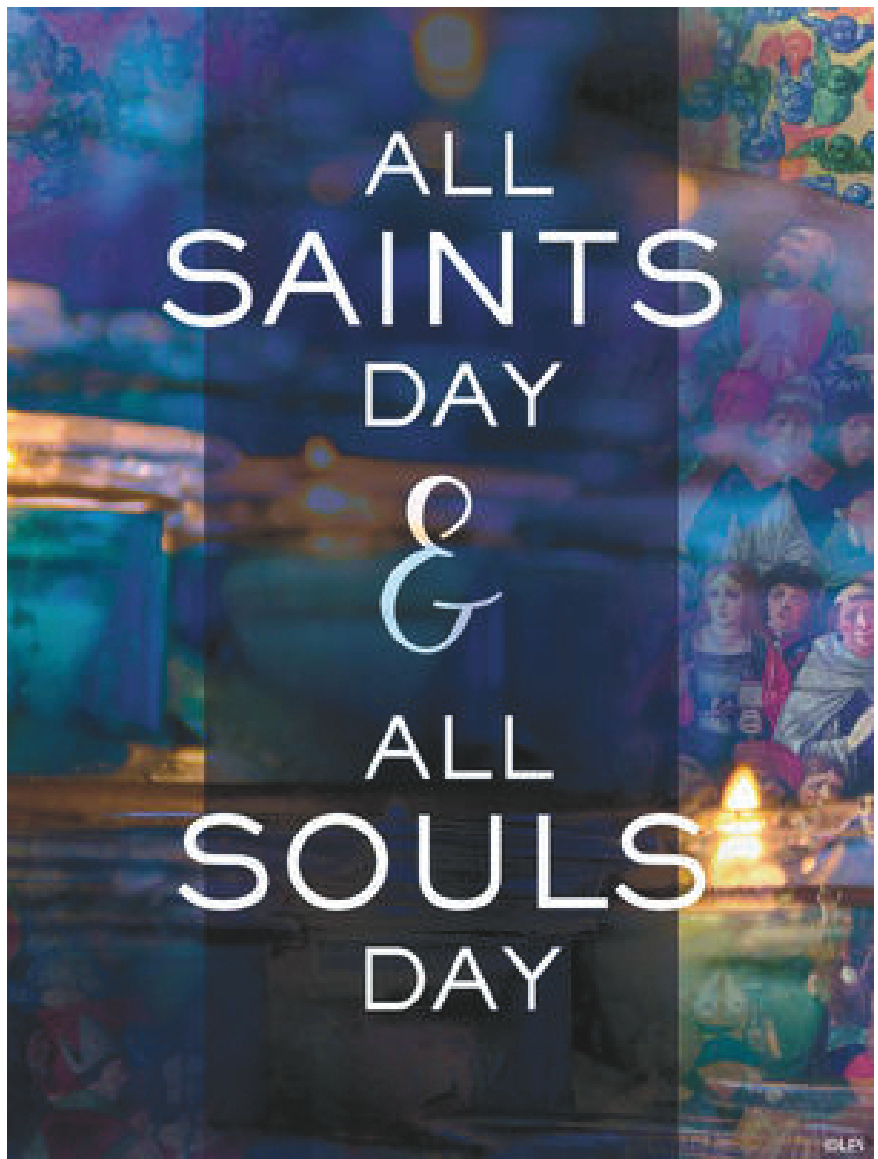
Marriage and Family

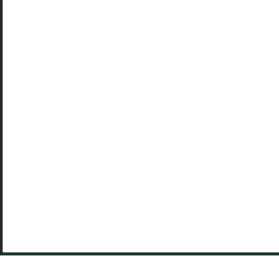

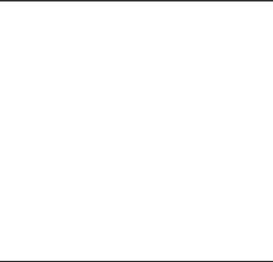

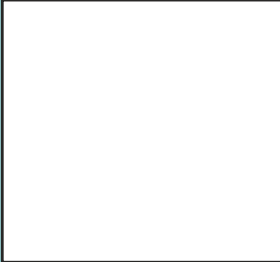
