February 15th marks the end of an era. Mary Wanhala retires after nearly two decades of service on the staff of our church. Over the years, Mary has coordinated and engaged in outreach to parishioners and neighbors, bringing a touch of charity and kindness to those in need and especially to those cut off from other sources of life due to physical or other limitations. While her work drew many people here together in community, Mary has been clear we shall not have a retirement party for her. (I don't think it requires permission for any of us to send her a card, however). We pray for Mary to find great joy in retirement and hope we can continue the good work she has begun. While bringing a maternal heart to her work, Mary also would remind us the consequences of our actions and of our fidelity to Jesus Christ in the Catholic Faith. I thought about simply quoting the first part of the following passage, which impels us to the kind of outreach Mary has coordinated for us. But I know Mary would insist we read the whole thing. With gratitude and commitment, we ponder the words of Matthew's Gospel, chapter 25:

31 "When the Son of man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. **32** Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, **33** and he will place the sheep at his right hand, but the goats at the left. **34** Then the King will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; **35** for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, **36** I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' **37** Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see thee hungry and feed thee, or thirsty and give thee drink? **38** And when did we see thee a stranger and welcome thee, or naked and clothe thee? **39** And when did we see thee sick or in prison and visit thee?' **40** And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me.' **41** Then he will say to those at his left hand, 'Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; **42** for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, **43** I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.' **44** Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see thee hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to thee?' **45** Then he will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to me.' **46** And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." God bless you, Mary, for your service and for your role in helping others respond to this call to serve.
