Natural Family Planning Northland Family Programs Call Susie Marchetti at 218-966-0899 Come, Holy Spirit! We are blessed to have our Bishop Daniel here this weekend for the 10:00 Mass, praying for and conferring the gift of the Holy Spirit upon our confirmandi. Since our Bishop has arrived, he has been speaking of our need to grab onto the wings of the Holy Spirit and mobilize to mission. All of us can draw on the gift of the Spirit we have received and ask for its deepening as we seek to spread and defend the Faith. That is what the sacrament of Confirmation is for! To give us the gifts we need to spread Jesus' love and truth and invite others into a deep relationship with Him.

As a refresher, I'd like to share what the Catechism of the Catholic Church says are the effects of Confirmation:

The effect of the sacrament of Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost.

1303 From this fact, Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!";117

- it unites us more firmly to Christ;

- it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;

- it renders our bond with the Church more perfect;118

- it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross:119

Recall then that you have received the spiritual seal, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgment and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence, the spirit of holy fear in God's presence. Guard what you have received. God the Father has marked you with his sign; Christ the Lord has confirmed you and has placed his pledge, the Spirit, in your hearts.120

1304 Like Baptism which it completes, Confirmation is given only once, for it too imprints on the soul an indelible spiritual mark, the "character," which is the sign that Jesus Christ has marked a Christian with the seal of his Spirit by clothing him with power from on high so that he may be his witness.121

1305 This "character" perfects the common priesthood of the faithful, received in Baptism, and "the confirmed person receives the power to profess faith in Christ publicly and as it were officially (quasi Ex officio)."

Strengthened by the Spirit, let us make disciples and grow in union with Jesus! Come, Holy Spirit!
