



The **Novena to the Holy Spirit**, the oldest novena, was instituted by the risen Jesus Himself when He sent His apostles to go to Jerusalem to pray. "And behold, I am sending the promise of My Father upon you; but stay in the city until you are clothed with the

power from on high". (Luke 24:49) The gifts of the Holy Spirit poured upon the Apostles at Pentecost enabled them to proclaim with charity, clarity and boldness all that Jesus taught them. The gifts received then, at the birth of the Church, are the same gifts we receive from the Holy Spirit. Charity, clarity, and boldness in passing on all that Jesus gave us is as much needed now as it was then. The Pentecost Novena to the Holy Spirit begins Fri., May 19th and concludes on Pentecost Sunday, May 28th. Pray that the Holy Spirit will enflame the hearts of the faithful, with the fire of God's love, that they may in turn help enkindle a flame in the unbelieving, the lukewarm and the ignorant. Copies of the novena can be picked up at the entrances of the church.



St. Rita of Cascia | **May 22** St. Rita of Cascia (1381 – 1457) had the opportunity to live her life as a wife, mother, widow, and eventually, member of a religious community. Born in central Italy, St. Rita felt the calling to become a nun, but was pressured at a young age into marriage. During her 18

-year marriage to a cruel man, she raised two sons. When her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons died, St. Rita decided to go back to her first love and attempted to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. Her status as a widow caused some complications to her entering, but she eventually succeeded in professing vows. Throughout her lifetime, St. Rita of Cascia was known for her prayerfulness and charity. She also experienced stigmata on her forehead, meditated frequently on Christ's passion, and cared for the nuns of her religious community and those in the lay community who came to her for counsel. © LPi


