

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER MATTHEW MILLER

Dear Parishioners,

As many of you know, I will be moving to Brainerd for my new assignment. Not surprisingly, it will be hard to make this transition; yet, what always runs parallel with the difficulty of departing are the reasons that departing is difficult.

Those reasons, namely, are all of you. I have had a blessed first year of priesthood, and I have you all to thank for that. The generosity you all have shown me brought much joy to my priesthood. I will truly miss you all. The departure of priests, as many in this cluster know, is a common thing. For all priests, departing a parish flows naturally from our vocation to serve those to whom God calls us. As such, I must go to Brainerd.

Many people I spoke to about my departure responded saying, "well, you might come back." The reality that this was a common response pervaded my thoughts. In truth, I may come back, but I may not, none of us know for sure. Nonetheless, the common response that longs for a future reunion reveals something true about human nature: as brothers and sisters in Christ, we are meant for community. Yet as we know, this complete and total union is not possible in this life, it never could be. Doing what God wills us to do often takes us priests away from those whom we know and love.

Nonetheless, we as priests accept these challenges in our desire to serve God and do his will.

For me, God has communicated his will to me by obedience to my superior. This, in some senses, is a blessing. The decision on where God wants to me to serve is out of my hands; yet, that is not the case for many of us reading this. In addition, as you well know, it is not just priests who are called to serve our Lord, we are all called serve our Lord in some way. For some, this may take us away those whom we know and love. While the difficulty of parting may be a factor in deciding whether to move away, and an important one at that, it need not be the only factor we consider. What needs to be the deciding factor in a decision is whether or not God wills that we do something or not. And while this may cause a certain sorrow, if we must move, have no fear. As I was saying, complete reunion cannot be had on this earth. Often, God's will is difficult, for our hearts truly desire communion. True communion, however, will be fulfilled in heaven. As such, we must do God's will now, even if it is difficult. We find out God's will if we are people striving to know God. Thus, we must go to Mass, pray daily, and go to confession regularly. In these things, we have true union with God, the one relationship we were made for that will be fulfilled in heaven. It is our relationship with God that will unite us with our brothers and sisters in Christ, the fulfillment of which will be in heaven.

Please know of my prayers for you all, I will miss you all.

FAITH FORMATION

Today we will hear in Mark's Gospel how Jesus sent out the twelve to continue His ministry. These twelve were selected from among Jesus' disciples, we will hear in next week's Gospel these twelve referred to as the twelve apostles. The word apostle means "one who is sent." Jesus' instructions to the twelve were very specific. They were to preach and to share his authority to heal and to drive out demons. They were to travel very lightly without the customary food, money, and extra set of clothes, and to travel in pairs.

Jesus continues to send us into the world as his disciples. And like the first apostles, we are not sent alone either. Jesus wants us to tell people about his love for us and to help people in his name. But he doesn't expect us to do this job alone. He wants us to work with others.

Just as when we work together as friends and families to accomplish tasks, we know that the benefits are more than efficiency. In sharing daily tasks, we accomplish more, but we also build relationships that last.

The Church is the community of disciples who teach people about Jesus and who help others in his name. The community of the church helps support us in our ministry and our life of Christian Discipleship. In our work with others, we build this community of faith and can invite others to share in it.

Jesus continues to give us a community with which we share our life of discipleship—our family and the community of the Church. As we return to a more normal state of life, try and partake in the community life of your parish. Ask the Holy Spirit to help us rely on the support of the community of the church as we go out into the world as Disciples of Christ.
