

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER CHARLES FRIEBOHLE

People often will ask a priest that if he could choose one assignment, what would that be? If you talk to most priests, however, they end up loving whatever assignment they are in. The reason for this is that as a priest you are walking most intimately with your parishioners towards God. As John says,

“Nothing gives me greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.” (3 John 1:4) I could sit down and make a pros and cons list of my new assignment, but I know that God will surprise me along the way especially filling me with joy as I see the faithful walking in the truth.

I have had the unique opportunity of already living here for a few months, and have already been filled with that joy as I have slowly come to know some of the lay faithful here. I hope that I will be able to meet many more of you as we journey together on this path of holiness. GOSPEL MEDITATION

We hear in today's Gospel, Jesus inviting his disciples to rest after their ministry. As we heard last week these twelve had been sent out to preach repentance, heal the sick, and drive out demons. When they returned to Jesus, they were tired.

Family demands can make us feel like Jesus and the twelve apostles. We wish for times of relaxation and renewal, but there are errands to do, household chores to keep up with, volunteer commitments to keep. These are all good things, but we can be left feeling drained and tired as we try to keep up.

Summer months provide a greater freedom to enjoy time for recreation. We are blessed to have opportunities to choose how to spend our time. Jesus wants us to take time for rest and relaxation and to also spend some of that quiet time in prayer.

After a busy day of fun activities many people like to relax by spending time with family, reading, or listening to music. Jesus knew his Disciples were tired and wanted to spend some quiet time with them at the end of a long day. He also knows that we get tired and He also wants to spend quiet time with us each day too.

As we settle in at the end of the day, spend time with Jesus in prayer. Take this time as a family to end each day in quiet prayer time together. Encourage your children to pray before they go to sleep at night. If your family hasn't prayed evening prayer together, take this time to teach your family evening prayer and pray it together. It can be found on the Ibrevariary app or webpage.

As the summer months continue, ask God to help you find time to renew yourselves so that you might be better disciples of Jesus Christ. Ask Him to help your family appreciate the importance of including time for rest, relaxation, and prayer as they learn how to be disciples of Christ too.
