

#### A MESSAGE FROM Fr. Anthony Wroblewski

This past week we celebrated the Feast of All Souls. As you know, All Souls Day is a day to pray for all who have died. Prayers are offered for those in purgatory, who are being purified before they can see the Beatific Vision. Our churches have provided a Book of

the Dead, in which parishioners have an opportunity to write the names of relatives to be remembered. They are available in both Churches throughout the Month of November. Additionally, on the Feast Day, we celebrated a Mass at 6PM, especially honoring and praying for parishioners who died this past year, their names were read out, and a candle lit for each one. Then families were able to take that candle home with them, to continue to pray for their loved ones. Listed below are the names of our beloved parishioners who have died this past year.

Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them.






