A MESSAGE FROM FATHER CHARLES FRIEBOHLE



St. John Bosco says, "If we want to have a good society, we must concentrate all our forces on the Christian education of the young. Experience has taught me that if we wish to sustain civil society then we should take good care of the young." As we celebrated Catholic Schools this past week, this was something that I wondered about. What impact will the students that are currently attending the Catholic

schools in the Diocese of Duluth have on society?

It is always refreshing to be able to go in to the classrooms in the Catholic schools and see that the education they are receiving is not just about grades, standardized tests, or college placement, but it is most importantly about the student's relationship with God. We all naturally are seeking a relationship with God, but so often we do not know how to go about getting to know, love, and serve Him. In the Catholic schools, the students are able to do this day in and day

Often, we can underestimate the ability of a young person to have a relationship with God. As students ask questions in class, I can see that they truly have a desire to come to know, love and serve God. Sometimes they just ask questions out of curiosity, such as where do priests live, do they eat food, or why do you wear sandals? Other times they are asking questions that I would never be able to fully explain, such as why did God create us, why did Jesus have to die and suffer on the cross, or why are there people who do not believe in God? When I leave classrooms, I wonder what other questions the students have that go unasked.

These questions, whether they seem silly or not, point to the reality that they are searching for that knowledge and relationship with God. The more that they can grow closer in that relationship, not only is it good for them, but good for society as a whole. That relationship with God is something that all of us are working on, and the closer we get to God, the better it is for society. The beautiful thing about Catholic education is that we are helping give the youth a jump start in that relationship. I ask you to continue to support our Catholic Schools, and continue to pray that the students truly can discover their relationship with God and transform society for the better.


