Lenten Fasting & Abstinence: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Stations of the Cross and Parish Suppers: We have multiple opportunities at our parishes this Lent to pray the Stations of the Cross as well as to enjoy meals together. Stations will be prayed at 5:30 PM on Wednesdays at St. Mary Star of the Sea beginning March 9 followed by a Soup Supper in the Social Hall. Stations will be prayed at 5:30 PM on Fridays at the Cathedral followed by a Lenten Supper in the Social Hall. You are invited for prayer and fellowship!

Pyx Policy: We are so grateful for all of you who bring the Lord's presence in the Eucharist to those who are unable to get to Mass. We certainly want you to continue in that ministry. However, we also want to follow the policies and direction of our Diocese. The Diocese requires us to know who is bringing the Eucharist to the homebound, and to whom they are going. The Diocese also requires the parish to maintain records and ensure proper training, which is above and beyond normal Eucharistic ministry training since the Lord is being brought outside of the church building. For those who bring the Eucharist to the homebound, we need you to click the link found in the weekly newsletter or contact Greg Jung (greg.jung@duluthcatholic.org or 218 -623-5013) to complete a questionnaire so we have a better understanding of who is distributing Holy Communion and so we can follow up with the required training.

The training is for both new and current Liturgical Ministers. It will be held Tuesday, March 8 at 6 PM at St. Mary Star of the Sea. A MESSAGE FROM FATHER ANTHONY Wroblewski

Earlier this past week, as I was getting ready for Ash Wednesday, I realized that this may be the first "somewhat normal" Lent we've had since the year 2019! It is hard to believe that we have

been living with covid restrictions for such a long time. This year, we are finally going to be able to return to some of the Lenten practices we had back before the pandemic began. And since we are able to get back to those worthwhile practices and events, allow me to mention a few of them, hoping that you will make time to attend many, if not all of them.

Already last week, we began one of those devotions: **The Stations of the Cross**. Every Friday at 5:30pm, the Cathedral has Stations of the Cross, followed by a Lenten supper downstairs in the social hall. At St. Mary Star of the Sea, we gather every Wednesday at 5:30pm to pray the devotion, and again gather downstairs in the hall for soup supper. Stations are a devotion that can be done anytime. I still remember seeing one lady who used to come to my home church every Friday and do the Stations by herself. But it is an especially important devotion to pray during Lent, when we recall all that Jesus did to save us. What a great way to be reminded of His enormous sacrifice. And then, we are able to finally enjoy some fellowship with each other, which has been so lacking during the pandemic.

Another beautiful tradition that went by the wayside during covid was a **Parish Mission**. In the east side of Duluth, we are hoping to be able to offer two missions a year: one at the Cathedral, and one at our neighboring parishes in the Fall. We need those opportunities to be nourished spiritually. It is my hope that you will make those opportunities your own private retreat experience. This year, in just one month, Fr. Louis Studer will be with us. He is a good friend of mine. He currently serves at the Provincial Superior for the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, the Order that I once belonged to. His theme for this year's Mission is: Finding God in People, Places and Events. What will be unique is that Father Studer will give 7 talks: 4 in the evenings at the Cathedral, and 3 right after the noon Masses at St. Mary. So those who can will be able to hear 7 different talks while he is here.

So, I invite you this Lent to really enter into the season. Make sure your sacrifice this year is truly a sacrifice. Take extra time to pray these next 40 days. Find time to reconnect with your fellow parishioners at the meals we will have with one another. And then be ready to enter into Holy Week. May God Bless your Lenten journey.

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



FAITH FORMATION

On this the first Sunday of Lent, we hear how Jesus was tempted by the devil in the desert. At this point in his life, Jesus has been Baptized, but hasn't quite started his public ministry. Perhaps it is a time of transition, or a turning point for Jesus in his life. Most of us can probably relate to such times as these in our own lives. It could have been a time when we accepted a new job, bought a new house, or had a new baby. After the moment of decision is made, when there is no turning back, we might sometimes begin to wonder if we are prepared and ready for the task before

Major life decisions like these can bring about feelings of doubt and insecurity in our lives. Jesus's response to the temptations of the devil in the desert offer an example to us in how we can better respond to situations like these. He shows us how to respond in faith when doubts and insecurities tempt us to distrust God or to not trust in Him fully. Every time Jesus rebukes the devil, we see his trust in God. He has so much confidence in God's protection and faithfulness that he is able to rebuke the devil over and over again.

We learn to trust God with the big things by first trusting him with the little things. When we do this, we will begin to understand that we are dependent upon God for all that we have and all that we are.

Our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving invite us to trust God in these small ways. They prepare us to trust in Him in all things, especially in moments of doubt and uncertainty. During this Lenten season, let us work towards gaining the same confidence that Jesus had in the face of temptation.

Faith Formation resumes this week with our normal class schedule along with our First Communion sacramental prep classes.


