A MESSAGE FROM **FATHER ANTHONY** Wroblewski

We Catholics have certain practices that may be familiar to many of our older folks, but many younger people may not fully understand or appreciate. Something you may see in bulletins, or an-

nounced at each Mass are intentions for Masses. Perhaps you've wondered about this, but never felt comfortable asking. So, I thought that it might be helpful to write an educational article on Mass intentions. It's a Catholic tradition that dates back to as early as the year 180, with evidence of early Christians having a Mass said for a loved one. Here are a few things to consider when having a Mass offered:

- 1. The suggested offering for Mass intentions is \$10 **per Mass.** It is customary to give an offering when requesting a Mass for an intention. The Diocese sets the suggested amount for the whole Diocese. And in Minnesota, the Dioceses together set the suggested amount.
- 2. A Mass can be offered for a person who is still **living.** Though we often have Mass said for those who have passed away, helping them on their way to heaven, Masses also can be offered for those who are still alive. So if you know someone who could benefit from the spiritual graces that come with having a Mass offered on their behalf, please do so.
- 3. You can have a Mass said in Thanksgiving or for a celebration. Most people remember to have a Mass said for a deceased loved one, or for a special intention, perhaps a friend who is suffering. Rarely do we think of having a Mass offered to show our gratitude to God. Masses can be said for birthdays, anniversaries, or in thanksgiving for prayers that have been answered!
- 4. It's not a long or difficult process to request a **Mass.** Simply submit your Mass request directly to the parish office where you want the Mass said.
- 5. Because the Mass is the highest form of worship on Earth, there are many fruits and graces that result from having a Mass said. The reason that this tradition has been passed on for centuries is because of the many spiritual fruits that result from this form of prayer. The celebration of the Eucharist is the highest form of worship in the Catholic Church because we unite ourselves with Christ's sacrifice on the cross in worship of his Father. St. John Paul II said: "The Church believes that she will be heard, for she prays in union with Christ her Head and Spouse, who takes up this plea of His Bride and joins it to His own redemptive sacrifice." Don't miss out on these graces for yourself and those you love! What a gift it is you can give to someone, either living or deceased, to have the greatest prayer in the Church said for your loved one!

FAITH FORMATION

Last Sunday we heard Matthew's account of Jesus' Baptism. on the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today, we hear John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus as found in John's Gospel.

John's Gospel differs from the other Gospels because John does not describe Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Instead, we hear John the Baptist giving witness to who Jesus is, the Son of God.

John the Baptist knew that his job was to prepare the way for Jesus. When he saw Jesus coming toward him, John acknowledged him as the Lamb of God and knew that it was time to announce the work that Jesus would do: take away the sin of the world.

John tells us that he baptized in order to prepare for and make known the ministry of the One who was to follow. John's witness is an excellent example of what it means to be a disciple. By our Baptism, we too are called to make Jesus known to all the world by our words and by the witness of our lives. The ministry of John the Baptist prepared for and pointed to the ministry of Jesus. In a similar way, our lives are to offer testimony to who we know Jesus to be for us and for the world.

Pray that like John the Baptist, our lives will show others that Jesus is the Son of God, the lamb who takes away the sins of the world.


