A MESSAGE FROM FATHER ANTHONY Wroblewski

Next weekend some of our young people will be receiving the true Body of the Lord for the first time. I thought I would once again share with you a bit of what Pope Benedict once said to a group of people gathered who were

preparing for 1st Communion:

Dear parents! I ask you to help your children to grow in faith, I ask you to accompany them on their journey towards First Communion, a journey which continues beyond that day, and to keep accompanying them as they make their way to Jesus and with Jesus. Please, go with your children to Church and take part in the Sunday Eucharistic celebration! You will see that this is not time lost; rather, it is the very thing that can keep your family truly united and centered. Sunday becomes more beautiful, the whole week becomes more beautiful, when you go to Sunday Mass together. And please, pray together at home too: at meals and before going to bed. Prayer does not only bring us nearer to God but also nearer to one another. It is a powerful source of peace and joy. Family life becomes more joyful and expansive whenever God is there and his closeness is experienced in prayer.

Dear catechists and teachers! I urge you to keep alive in the schools the search for God, for that God who in Jesus Christ has made himself visible to us. I know that in our pluralistic world it is no easy thing in schools to bring up the subject of faith. But it is hardly enough for our children and young people to learn technical knowledge and skills alone, and not the criteria that give knowledge and skill their direction and meaning. Encourage your students not only to raise questions about particular things - something good in itself - but above all to ask about the why and the wherefore of life as a whole. Help them to realize that any answers that do not finally lead to God are insufficient.

Dear priests and all who assist in parishes! I urge you to do everything possible to make the parish a "spiritual community" for people - a great family where we also experience the even greater family of the universal Church, and learn through the liturgy, through catechesis and through all the events of parish life to walk together on the way of true life.

These three places of education - the family, the school and the parish - go together, and they help us to find the way that leads to the sources of life, and truly all of us, dear children, dear parents and dear teachers, want to have "life in abundance".



FAITH FORMATION

The fourth Sunday of Easter is often called Good Shepherd Sunday because in the Gospel reading for today, Jesus talks about what it means to be the shepherd of the sheep.

Almost everybody in Jesus' time knew about sheep and shepherding, so when Jesus explained his ideas by talking about sheep, people understood. Even though we have less experience with sheep and shepherds today in our society, we can still understand the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd.

In the image of the Good Shepherd, we recognize that the shepherd knows and cares for his sheep, so the sheep trust him and follow him. The relationship between the sheep and their shepherd is based on familiarity. Sheep recognize his voice and will not follow a stranger.

Today we still talk about shepherds when we describe Christian leaders. Our Bishop and Priests are often referred to as our Shepherds. They, as our shepherd, know us, and we know them. By following the example of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, and by being faithful to him, they lead us to him.

Just as the shepherd calls his sheep, Jesus the Good Shepherd knows us by name, calls us, loves us and cares for us. We are the sheep. We trust and follow him. He is the gate for all of us, and there is only one way to eternal life and that way is through him.

The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want. Psalm 23-1
