# COLLAR COMMENTARY- FR. JUSTIN



Where was I last weekend? I went to Philadelphia for my final exam of this year in Bioethics. It was a great weekend. I wish that the experiences I had could be had by all.

What struck me most was the collection of the group and the activity we were all actively engaged in. The group consisted of doctors, nurses, hospital administrators, priests, and catechists. Striking about the group was everyone's competence and interest in bioethical questions. They were all unapologetically Catholic and extremely docile to the teachings of the Church. They were trying to grow in bringing the light of Christ and the faith He reveals to the difficult questions they encounter in their medical practice and pastoral ministry.

The ethicists from the National Catholic Bioethics Center were all so impressive. Philosophers, theologians, a nurse practitioner – all of them deeply Catholic, and formed in the Church's moral teaching. Watching them tackle questions of medical procedures, treatments, etc. with the lights of their own brilliance and the Catholic faith was extremely edifying and formation-enriching.

We live in a world where the impression we get is that any serious thinker or self-respecting intelligent person doesn't have faith and certainly isn't Catholic. This group puts that impression out to pasture. Talking about this in the rectory, someone pointed out that when people go to college, especially if it is a state school, the smartest people you run into in your classes or as your professors probably are not believers, and almost certainly are not faithful Catholics. While there no doubt are exceptions, by and large, the majority of those people in those positions do seem to be irreligious, some are passively, but some are aggressively anti-religious.

However, there is nothing about serious thought or high competency in scientific and medical matters that prevents one from believing in Jesus Christ and what he teaches in His Church. In fact, the best doctors I know are also very inspiring Catholics. These people, though rare, are out there. And bringing them all together was an impressive sight to see. It gives me a lot of confidence and hope.

I would like to share that confidence and hope with you. Our Catholic Faith is so beautiful and it is true. Beautiful, true and good; they are connected.

When you face difficult medical decisions, part of informed consent is knowing also the necessary moral and spiritual information. Spiritual and pastoral care are important components to health care. As Catholics, we have a great insight into the totality of the human person and all of the necessary considerations that go into making good health care decisions. When things get complicated, it is nice to know that there are people out there who are there to help think through them and bring the light of Christ and His teaching into every set of particular and complicated circumstances.

Today's Gospel (John 15: 9-17) comes from Jesus' final testament to his disciples at the Last Supper. Peter realized that he had been chosen to be a leader and that was true of the other disciples, too. They learned from Jesus that the only point of being chosen was to spread the love they had received. We learn this from Jesus, too. We remember that to be a follower of Christ is to realize that we too are chosen to spread God's love without distinction. Even though we may be tempted to exclude someone, to build a wall or close a door, that is a temptation we must reject if we are to love as Jesus commands us.

In family life, we have many opportunities to show love in action. We aren't talking about romantic love here, but love in action, love that costs a price. Each time we postpone a task to tend to the needs of another, we show ourselves to be on the path to following the example of love shown to us by Jesus. Parents who work an extra shift so that their child can go to camp or to the prom or the homemaker who knows of a neighbor's need and prepares food for them. Or it could be a man who gives up fishing or golfing to visit and tend to his aging parents. It is a big investment to be a parent and a loving person and we applaud you for your loving kindness.

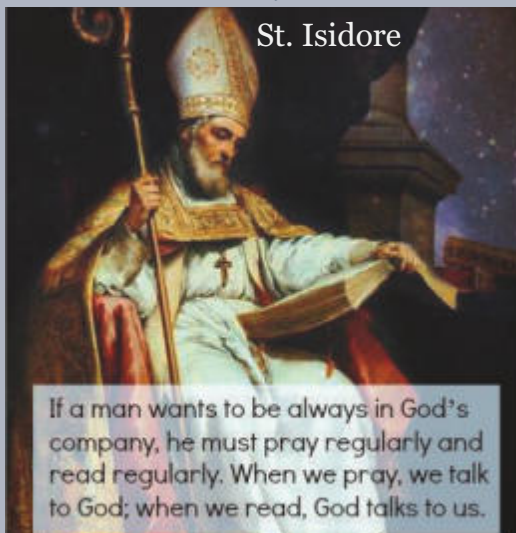
