

Where to Give to Help Ukraine

Various Catholic agencies are collecting donations to aid with the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, as people flee to escape Russian bombing and shelling. Here are some places to donate. This list is not exhaustive.

- The international Caritas confederation is collecting funds to help Caritas Ukraine. In the United States, that is through *Catholic Relief Services*.
- The Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia: *ukrarcheparchy.us/donate*.

- Two pontifical agencies also are taking donations for Ukraine: *Catholic Near East Welfare Association* and *Aid to the Church in Need.*
- The Knights of Columbus launched the *Ukraine Solidarity Fund* for humanitarian needs in Ukraine and through refugee sites in Poland.
- Donations can also be made to *Jesuit Refugee Service* to support the agency's work with those forced to flee conflict in Europe.





As much as we need to be welcomed, we are also the one who needs to do the welcoming and mercy giving. Those we love need our guidance, but they don't always take it. We know that what they are doing is off the mark, self-destructive and wrong. We have to let them go and let it happen, even though they might get hurt. As we wait and hope, they choose to make their way back to us. They don't need us to judge them. They have done enough of that to themselves. We immediately embrace them and are just happy they're home. God uses us to help heal them. Knowing how much we craved understanding and forgiveness ourselves, we can now freely give it away. God uses what he has taught us to teach others.

We are also the entitled ones. At least we "think" we are entitled. After all, we work hard for what we have. We cannot get our heads around the idea that someone can get something that I really deserve! If I do what I'm supposed to do, I ought to be rewarded for that, right? Rosary Guild


