#### **Chastisement and Guilt**

It may not be pleasant to consider the chastisement of God. But it must be understood that His chastisements are real and are an act of His abundant Mercy. When souls turn from God and refuse His Mercy, this deeply wounds His Heart. As a result, God becomes more "passionate" so to speak in His tireless pursuit. One way He seeks to open their hearts is through chastisements. Think of the Pharisees, for example. They were filled with pride and egotism and the Lord rebuked them harshly. But He did so to win them back as an act of great Mercy. It worked for some, for others it did not.

Are you aware of the chastisements of God? For example, have you felt the pain of extreme guilt for your sins? If so, pay attention to this. Know that if you have gone astray, especially through pride, the Lord will pour down judgment upon you. If you persist, He will pour it down with a vengeance. And when a soul remains obstinate, God's Mercy cannot enter. But when these chastisements produce a sense of holy guilt, this means that the conscience is working and is in a position to change. Do not hold onto guilt and do not ignore it. Run to the Mercy of God so that He can free you from your sin and return His peace to your heart.

Lord, please give me the grace I need to turn to You in all things. May I never be in need of the fierce chastisements of Your Mercy. But if I am in need of this grace, please help me to respond with conversion from my sins. Jesus, I trust in You.

# Following After Mary in the Fragrance of Her Holiness

I continue and conclude my reflection on the Immaculate Conception begun last week.

It is the desire of the Our Lord that we listen to His Mother's voice as we listen to His voice. She speaks to us, instructs us in perfect accord with what she knows from the Heart of her Son. She will counsel you and guide your steps toward the path of holiness that Jesus has laid out for us. She is intimately present to each of us. There is not one detail of our lives that is not of concern or interest to her. Honor her presence in your

life. Do not forsake the prayer of the Rosary. It binds you to her and she to you. It is no accident that the rosary is fashioned as a sacred cord.

You see, all of this is the on-going playing out of the meaning of Our Lady's Immaculate Conception. It's more than some mere intellectual dogma. Rather it is a reality in which we are invited to immerse ourselves in communion with Mary and Jesus. It is the secret to obtaining holiness. Without Mary's Son, nothing could be redeemed."

O sinless Virgin! Let us follow joyfully in your footsteps! Let us follow you in the fragrance of your holiness!

### **SACRAMENTS & SERVICES**

#### Marriage

Couples requesting the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the rector at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage. If a couple wishes to be married as a registered member of our parish, they must actively participate in the faith (Sunday worship) and be a registered member of Cathedral parish at least three months prior to requesting the Sacrament of Marriage. Weddings are not celebrated during Lent.

#### **Baptism**

Parents may request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. To request baptism, please call 782-0322.

#### Wills & Estates

As you prayerfully execute your will or do estate planning, please consider keeping the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman in mind. The most common and simplest way to include the parish in your last wishes is to include a bequest in your will or trust.

#### **Hospital Visits & Visitation of the Sick:**

To secure a priest for unplanned or emergency admissions to a local hospital, it is important that the patient, if possible, or a family member and/or friends, contact the hospital pastoral care department to have the on-call priest administer the sacraments. The on-call priest is considered part of the pastoral team and does not count toward the maximum number of visitors per day rule.

If you become homebound because of illness or a post hospital stay, and would like to be visited; or those who are seriously ill or have been sick for a long period of time should receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. Those with preplanned hospital procedures should call the parish office to make arrangements for anointing. If possible, one should be anointed apart from a hospital stay since there are visiting restrictions.




