

Sacrament of **Holy Orders**– Parishioners are urged to pray for and encourage anyone who might feel called to be a priest or deacon, or who might serve the church in religious life.

Visiting the Sick– Please notify the parish office of any parishioners who are homebound, sick, in hospitals, nursing homes and wish to be visited or receive Communion.

Catholic United Financial is collecting caps and mittens for the needy, boxes will be in St. Elizabeth and SS Peter and Paul churches.



<u>Epiphany House Blessing</u>. Ancient European custom is to bless your house on the Feast of Epiphany. Here's how: Gather your family at the front door. Read in your Bible Matthew 2:1-12. Take the piece of chalk blessed in Church today and write above the door: 20+C+M+B+22. The numbers stand for the year. The letters may stand for the traditional names of the Magi—Casper, Melchoir and Balthasaar. They may also be shorthand for Christus mansionem benedicat, Latin for "Christ bless this house."


