LEARNING TO TRUST

The apostle Paul is not an easy read. He uses run-on sentences and sparse punctuation. He also uses a lot of symbolism in his writing.

In his letter to the Corinthians he compares our individual experience to Jesus' death and resurrection on the cross. He says, "Jesus had died once and for all" and through "faith we have all been raised from the dead".

Paul also makes a distinction between the "flesh" which could be understood as our condition before we express our faith in Jesus Christ; and our life following our statement of faith, which is life in the spirit.

In the gospel of Mark, Jesus speaks about faith as a character value which keeps us afloat on rough waters. What he says to his disciples is, "Trust me, I will not let any harm come to you."

In ordinary ways, the Lord protects us from harm and ensures we might have a sense of peace. He does not promote us that we will never struggle through hard times, but he will be our guide through rough waters.

As we grow in faith, like a child who learns to trust his parent, we learn to trust the Lord and believe in his promise.

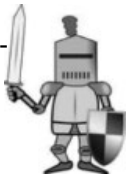

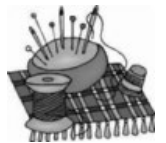

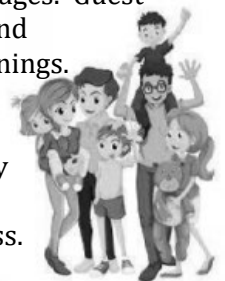
Catholic Question and Answer

Question: We are considering homeschooling our children. Does this present a problem when it is time for them to receive the sacraments? What must we do?

Answer: Homeschooling is legal in all fifty states and like other types of education, has its advantages and its drawbacks. There are many factors to consider, and each family has to decide what the best way to educate its children is. With religious education, many dioceses have a formal policy that outlines procedures and expectations, some of which include more than just academic information. Call the religious education office to find out what they are for your area.

In general, though, an appointment with your parish priest to discuss your situation is the best first step. An opportunity to discuss what is available, what the expectations are for each sacrament, and how you can best prepare your child helps make your time of preparation more effective. The priest can direct you to good catechetical materials, parent information classes, and other choices and possibilities for your child. All parents need to be part of their child's religious education, taking a lead in instilling the values and beliefs of their faith. Communication and information helps us all to teach and preach the Gospel as Jesus did. ©LPi

Eucharist for the homebound—If you are homebound and wish to receive Communion at home, call the church office at 634-3813.

Hospital Visits—If you find yourself or a loved one in the hospital, and would like a visit from a priest, please call the church office directly and leave the patient's name, room number, and name of hospital. Due to privacy laws, hospitals are not allowed to give out patient's names, making it challenging to know who would like a visit.



Anointing of the Sick is available on request. If you or a family member wish to be anointed before surgery, when in the hospital, or for any sickness, please contact Fr. Joe. He can be reached by calling the parish office at 634-3813, and if necessary, by leaving a message on Extension 20.

The Anointing of the Sick is offered at regular intervals in the parish and at area nursing homes.

Baptism Classes— Baptism class is required before a first Baptism. Parents expecting their first child should attend. For questions contact the church office.



The Wedding Policy of the Diocese of St. Cloud requires that you contact the parish at least 6 months prior to your wedding. This is necessary so that all the required steps can be completed in a timely manner. For second marriages, more time may be required. To begin your marriage preparation or for questions about the marriage preparation policy, contact Father Joe (634-3813).
