OUR NEXT STEPS

Our parish reached a major milestone this year with the final payment on the debt for our beautiful church – closing one chapter and opening the door to new opportunities. With this milestone behind us, we joyfully turn our focus to the future. Guided by the Holy Spirit, the Futures Team of Holy Family has carefully evaluated the capital needs and identified several key priorities to help our community continue to grow and thrive. We are now exploring several exciting projects that will enhance our worship, education, and community life.

KEY PRIORITIES

Renovate Our Parish Hall & Kitchen | \$1,647,488

The parish hall will be fully renovated to better serve parish gatherings, enhance community life, and provide new opportunities for revenue-generating events. The updated space will feature:

- Seating for up to 240 at round tables.
- Projection screens for presentations and special events.
- A full-service kitchen.
- Accessible restrooms.
- An entry ramp to ensure all parishioners can fully participate.

Expand the Fr. Riley Parish Center | \$802,224

To support growing ministries and educational programs, we plan to finish out the lower level of our church with:

- Main parish offices.
- Two classrooms.
- A board/meeting room.
- Accessible restrooms.
- Flexible seating areas for collaboration, small group meetings and fellowship.

Repair Our Historic Church \$300,000

Extensive repairs and restoration work will preserve our historic church and could give us space for weddings and community events. Our goal is to restore the building's grace. Projects include:

- Addressing critical structural issues.
- Repairing masonry.
- Replacing damaged windows.
- Upgrading electrical and lighting systems.
- Improving accessibility.

Add a Bell Tower & Elevator | \$576,238

A new elevator housed within a bell tower will greatly improve accessibility throughout the church and parish center. The bell tower will also honor the original vision for our church and connect us to our parish's rich heritage.

TOTAL COST | \$3,645,950

All costs are estimates, including contingencies and are subject to change.
