



ON SUNDAY, JUNE 19, MISSIONARY PRIEST FR. POLYCARP MBLARAWA WILL BE VISITING FROM NIGERIA TO MAKE APPEALS FOR HIS DIOCESE, MAIDUGURI. THE FOLLOWING IS A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE DIOCESE OF MAIDUGURI THAT WE RECEIVED FROM THEIR COORDINATOR OF APPEALS.

The History of Maiduguri Diocese and the Boko Haram Crisis

The Catholic Diocese of Maiduguri was created in 1966 with Bishop Timothy Cotter, OSA, as her first Bishop. Currently, it is overseen by Most Rev. Dr. Oliver Dashe Doeme. Today, 64 years later, it is comprised of six deaneries (Maiduguri, Potiskum, Biu, Mubi, Bazza Shuwa), 46 parishes and pastoral areas, 8 Catholic institutions and 31 secondary and primary schools.

The diocese is located in the northeastern part of Nigeria, covering a land mass of about 142,000 square kilometers and comprising of entire Borno State, Yobe State and Adamawa North Senatorial District. The diocese has 85 indigenous priests, 11 indigenous female religious, 54 major seminarians and a total population of 222,749 Catholics with an estimated general population of 7.3 Million. From this, it is obvious that the small population of Catholics live in a Muslim dominated environment and are constantly persecuted for their faith. Even before the crisis, there has been systematic exclusion of Christians from socio-economic, political and education spheres in the North. However, the current persecution has, in the last ten years, become ferocious and alarming. Yet despite this, there are Catholics who are fervent in faith, many wanting to become priests. Many are faithful to the Church despite persecution. Indeed the Church is growing in silence.

The Boko Haram Crisis

The violent conflict in North-East Nigeria propelled by a violent insurgency has led to widespread destruction. Currently of the institutions mentioned above, over eight schools have been burnt, three health centers destroyed and seven parishes are areas under Boko Haram control, so the parishioners have vacated and are displaced internally. There is still constant displacement, violations of international human rights laws, and a growing humanitarian crisis. The region has suffered greatly from the devastating impact of the crisis. In the three worst-affected states of Borno, Adamawa and Yobe, over two million people are internally displaced and human rights violations continue to be reported daily. Since 2009, over 36,000 people have been killed and more than 2,000 women and girls have been abducted. (European Parliament, P9_TA PROV 2020). Among the many displaced persons, many women have suffered sexual violence and their husbands are victims of brutal executions. Sadly, some women even have had children for the terrorists. Many girls have been victims of exploitation and abuse. Young men have been subjected to worst forms of torture and some have dropped out of school as victims of drug abuse.

As a result of all these great ordeals, a lot of our people have lost their livelihood, many living in camps as internally displaced persons and many more living with devastating consequences of displacement and grief. The crisis has broken social values, religious and spiritual cohesion, harmonious relations and the resilience of our people and communities. There is need to attend to their physical, psychological and social wounds so as to bring them healing.

In the midst of all these ordeals, one might ask if there is any hope. Indeed, surprisingly, the faith is growing strong. Our people are turning more and more to the church. We, as a church, are ever determined to keep witnessing to the gospel values and building the lives of our people. The Church stands as the beacon of hope that our people look up to. We have been engaged in helping the widows and orphans, forming little groups for their spiritual and economic wellbeing. We organize little youth groups, distribute food items and assist the children of the displaced in schools while struggling to rebuild some of our physical structures. We need so much help to enhance human and physical development of our people, to put back into their hands the power to grow and stand firm in faith. We rely on the generosity and patronage of donors and goodwill people to rebuild our lives, our people and our institutions.

Please come listen to Fr. Polycarp Mblarawa next Sunday, and then prayerfully consider how you can help your Catholic brothers and sisters on the other side of the world, whether through prayer or monetary donations.
