A NEW MUSICAL INSTRUMENT FOR ST KEVIN CHURCH

There is a need at St. Kevin Church to procure a musical system with an inbuilt music sequencer to facilitate liturgical music in the parish.

A **Music Sequencer** (or audio **sequencer** or simply **sequencer**) is a device or application software that can record, edit, or play back music, by handling note and performance information in several forms, typically CV/Gate, MIDI, or Open Sound Control (OSC), and possibly audio and automation data for DAWs and plug-ins. In short, a sequencer is a virtual keyboardist that performs whatever musical data is supplied to the musical instrument.

An appeal is therefore made to all those who would like to help in some way to raise the necessary funds to procure a new musical instrument at St. Kevin Church. All checks should be made out to *Guardian Angels Parish* with "St Kevin Music Upgrade" in the memo.

Or guilt the soul oppress;

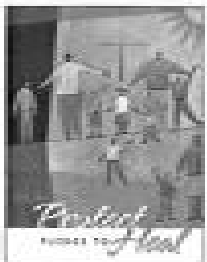
Our Lord, who gave Himself for you

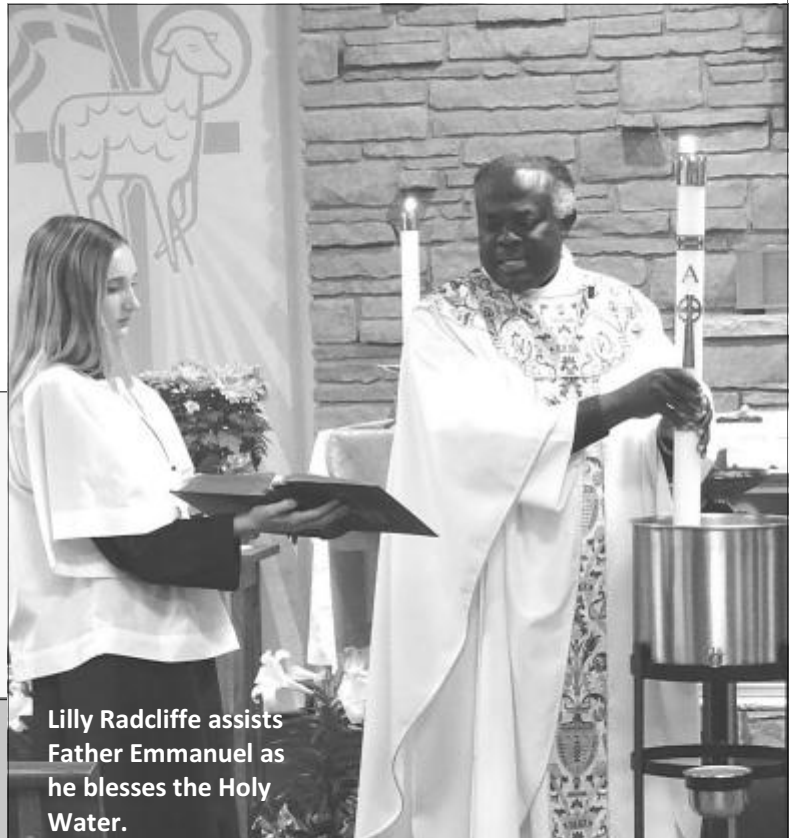
