Lenten Regulations

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22, 2023. Lenten regulations are as follows:

- 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
- In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated 2. their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

"YOU DON'T WANT TO HEAR ME SING!" (OH YES, WE DO!!)

I can't tell you how many times I have heard this phrase from members of our congregation. When encouraged to sing as a way to actively participate in the Liturgy, many of us are uncomfortable with the quality of our singing Voices. We don't think we have the capability to sing in tune or hit the high notes. But singing is one of the highest means of prayer! It is a way to share our faith, to serve our Church community and to express the love of God!

Music in our Liturgy is never about performance. It is not about entertainment. The role of music is to serve the needs of the Liturgy. It is one of the ways in which we are to be "fully engaged" in the Mass.

The US Council of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has provided a document, Sing To The Lord, Music in Divine Worship, 2007, *https://www.yakimadiocese.org/pdf/SingToTheLord.pdf*. This document provides ways in which music is to be used in our Liturgy.

So, how can you participate in this part of our service? As a member of the assembly, you can sing and chant as part of the Liturgy and participate in all the music. You can also join our choirs for regular Sunday Mass or Feast Days. Guardian Angels parish has our Kevinettes and has special choirs for Easter, funerals, and other special Feast Days. You can help by learning how to play the recorded music when the Liturgist is not in attendance. Finally, you can share your gifts if you play the piano/organ or another instrument.



The beauty of music in our liturgy is not about the quality of your voice! It is about joining our community of worshippers in expressing your love of God! Sing loud so God can hear us!
