



# May 8~4th Sunday of Easter

#### John 10:27-30

Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish.

No one can take them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all,

and no one can take them out of the Father's hand.

The Father and I are one."

#### first movement EVANGELIZATION to encounter

Read this gospel passage slowly and listen as if you hear Jesus speaking it directly to you. What feelings do the words evoke in you? Jesus promises that no one can take us away from him. How does this promise move your heart?

#### second movement DISCIPLESHIP to follow

Jesus calls us his sheep. He is our shepherd. Does this bring you comfort or do you chafe at the idea of being led? What areas of your life could use a shepherd?

Jesus says, "The Father and I are one" Jn 10:30. Have you ever reflected on the idea that the God who created the Universe loves you like a fierce shepherd guarding his sheep? Take time to contemplate this.

Being a shepherd in Jesus's day was a very low position in society. Yet, Jesus purposely connects himself to this menial job. Why do you think this is so? What message could Jesus be giving about the value of work? Do you have an attitude of respect and gratitude, not just for your own work, but that of others?

# third movement STEWARDSHIP to respond

Jesus is our example of a "Good Shepherd". Who in your life needs shep herding? How can Jesus help you to do this well?

What actions can you take this week to help those who you shepherd? If there are areas in your life where you need help, ask God to give you the courage to reach out.
