





Homily

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

Immediately following Mass, the church is cleaned and sanitized in preparation for Adoration and other scheduled events. This process takes time, so we respectfully ask you to leave the church immediately after Mass. If you are seeking fellowship, we invite you to visit outdoors.

Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) Loan Forgiven

We just received confirmation our loan through the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) established by the Federal CARES Act for \$81,700 is forgiven! We are both grateful and relieved. We especially thank Premier Bank, who did a great job working with us to obtain the loan.

The Small Business Administration implemented the PPP. The program's goals were to keep people employed and help small businesses and non-profit organizations continue to pay their employees even while experiencing financial difficulty. One requirement for forgiveness was spending 75% or more of the loan on payroll and having the same number of full-time equivalent employees over eight weeks, April 17 – June 12.



As is noted on our parish website, the name Bonaventure means “good event” and that can also describe the Giving Tree project this Christmas season. Again thank you for your generosity and care.


Craft Group News
