





#### **ROSARY CONGRESS**



October 6th @ 6 pm—October 7th @ 6 pm | Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception The Diocese of Wichita will host a 24-hour Rosary Congress. Beginning at 6 pm Wednesday with Mass and concluding with Solemn Vespers the next day.

Everyone in the Diocese is invited to sign up for an hour of Eucharistic Adoration and lead a rosary at the beginning of each hour. A minimum of 48 adorers are needed, two for each hour. Knights of Columbus will provide security throughout the event.

The first Rosary Congress took place in Poland from May 1st through May 7th, 1979 at the Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa in response to a governmental decision to restrict Pope John Paul II's visit to his home country.

"Who do you say that I am?" Jesus poses this question to His disciples, and He poses it to us as well. Like Peter, we should be able to give a correct response — the Messiah, my Savior, the Son of God — any of these would be theologically accurate responses. But do we actually allow Jesus to be those things? Do we recognize His divinity and step in place to follow and learn from Him? Or do we sometimes grow a bit smug in our knowledge and step in front of Him? In today's Gospel, Peter oversteps a boundary and rebukes Jesus for accepting the suffering that is ahead of Him. In turn, Jesus reminds Him to fall back in place — to watch and to follow. Peter is beginning to understand, but he still has much to learn and accept about the reality of his Messiah. This is likely true of us in our discipleship as well. Like Peter, we might get ahead of ourselves and abandon our FIAT. Suffering and "unanswered prayers" can usually draw us back to our knees in surrender to God and His will for our lives. Jesus reminds us that our lives are not our own, and that whoever dedicates his life to Jesus and the Gospel will have everlasting life.

#### St. Catherine of Genoa

1447—September 15, 1510 | Feast Day: September 15 Patron: Brides, widows, infertility, difficult marriages

Reflection: Catherine's teachings on the spiritual life were collected by her followers and published after her death. She is best known for her teachings on purgatory, which she saw not as an exterior fire but an inner one. The soul's ardent love for God burns like a fire, until all the remnants of sin are removed. She reminds us, who live in an age that takes sin lightly, of the pressing need to repent of our sins and do penance for them.

Prayer: St. Catherine of Genoa, pray that I may learn from your example to unite prayer with action. Amen

#### <u>St. Robert Bellarmine</u>

October 4, 1542—September 17, 1621 | Feast Day: September 17

Patron: Catechists, catechumens

Reflection: In his public life and role as a cardinal, Robert Bellarmine always stressed that personal prayer and conversion had to precede any external actions. He was an extremely busy man who made invaluable contributions to the Church's understanding of her own teachings and responsibilities. However, none of that would have been possible without his faithfulness to prayer—after all, we can't give what we don't have. How can I dedicate a little more time to prayer today?

Prayer: Jesus, you are the Truth. Saint Robert Bellarmine found such joy and fulfillment in bringing others to know you. I too want to know you more.
