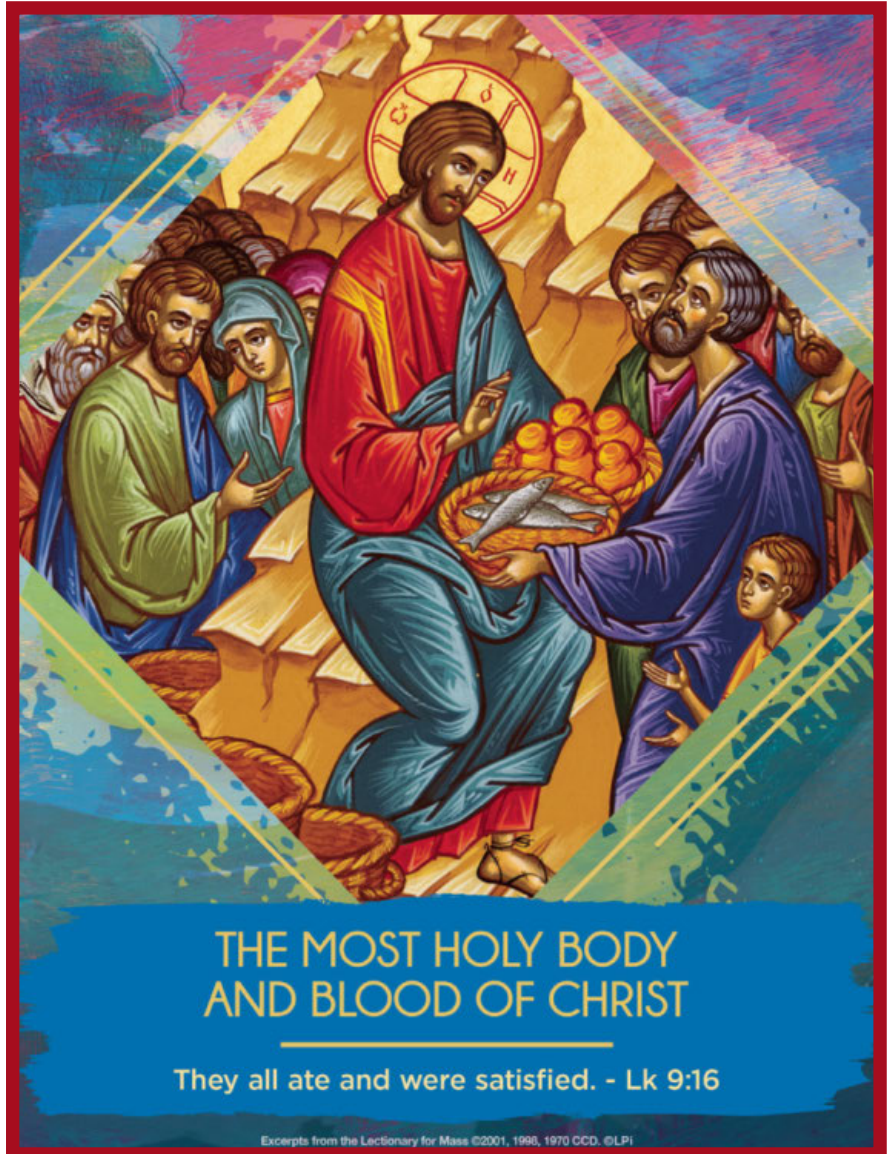

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

KEEPING OUR COMMUNITY SAFE

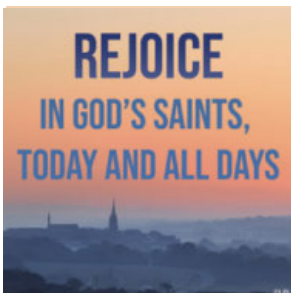

Basically - If you would not buy it, don't donate it.

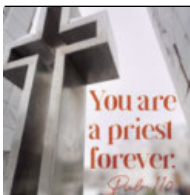
Garage sale dates:

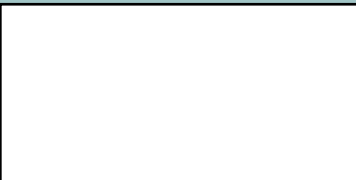

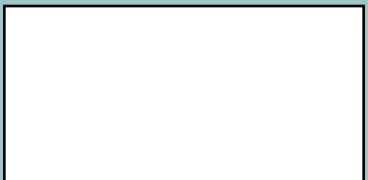
