Enrollment in Brown Scapular July 16th and 17th after all Masses

Fr. Terrell will have brown scapulars available for parishioners who are interested in being enrolled in the Brown Scapular. From the Carmelite Monastery of Terra Haute, Indiana: "The Scapular is a sign of Mary. One of the signs in the tradition of the Church from many centuries ago is the Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. It is a sign approved by the Church and accepted by the Carmelite Order as an external sign of love for Mary, of the trust her children have in her, and a commitment to live like her."

The brown scapular is a sign:

- * which has been approved by the Church for over 7 centuries;
- * which stands for the decision to follow Jesus like Mary;
- * be open to God and to His will be guided by faith, hope, and love;
- * to pray at all times;
- * to discover God present in all that happens around us.

A Note from Kim Krueger, DRE
