

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Diocese Ombudsman, Joe Crayon, at 816-812-2500 or crayon@ombudsmankcsj.org. If the abuse involves a priest, deacon, or employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City - St. Joseph.


