Youth Group, Catechism & Sacrament Registration

Registration is now being accepted for the 2019-2020 Youth Group, Catechism, and Sacrament Program at ICC which will begin on Friday, September 13.

- Classes will be taught by the ICC priests and Fraternity of St. Peter deacons and will meet weekly.
- High School & Adult and first communion through grade 8 will meet on Fridays from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m.
- There will **not** be Confirmation this year, but we **will** be teaching a First Communion Class. *Whether or not your child attends the class*, we do ask that you **complete the online registration** so that we are able to keep track of the children wishing to receive the sacrament.
- Any child (ages 13-17 inclusive) who wishes to attend Youth Group must also be registered.
- Classes will not meet:
 - *First Fridays, due to evening Mass.
 - *Day after Thanksgiving, Nov. 29
 - *Dec. 20, 2019 through Jan. 17, 2020, inclusive, due to Christmas break.
 - *Other days to be announced
- Registration will take place with an online form and will be open to parishioners beginning now until September 27. From September 27 on, registration will be open to all, space permitting. There is a link to the form on our web-site. Go to www.latinmassomaha.org and click the "Catechism" tab on the top. Those who prefer to register in person are asked to come to the parish office during regular business hours to register.
- **Registration form and Circle of Grace selection must be completed for both Catechism and Youth Group, as required by the Archdiocese of Omaha.**
- **Any child not baptized at ICC who wishes to receive First Communion in the spring must submit a newly-generated (dated within the last 6 months) baptismal certificate to the ICC office by Friday, Nov. 1.**
