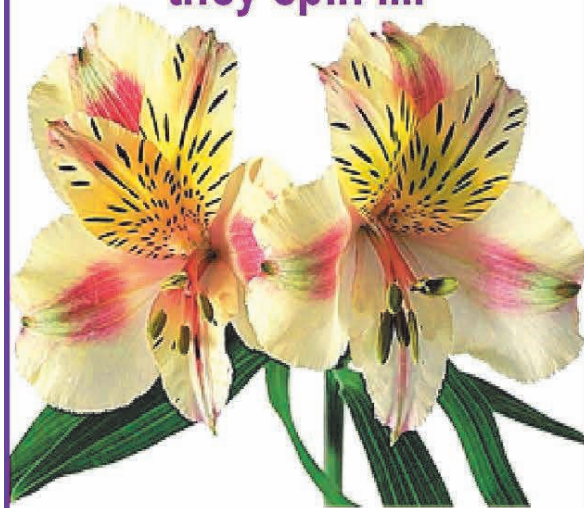

Restoring Catholic Culture

A brief look at what it is like when the world is Catholic

This Wednesday, Friday and Saturday are the Ember Days of September. Although no longer binding under sin, these are traditionally days of fast and abstinence from meat to beg blessings on the harvest and protection from storms and other calamities. If you would like to follow the centuries-old practice of the Church, you would abstain from meat on these days. In addition, you would eat only bread and coffee or tea at breakfast, and 8 ounce or less collation for one meal and a full (meatless) meal for the other. A more recent version of the practice would be to eat only one full meal and two smaller meals which, combined, do not equal a full meal. Meat would be eaten at only one meal. Whatever efforts are made on Ember Days are boosted by the Church with special graces, so all are encouraged to do something.
