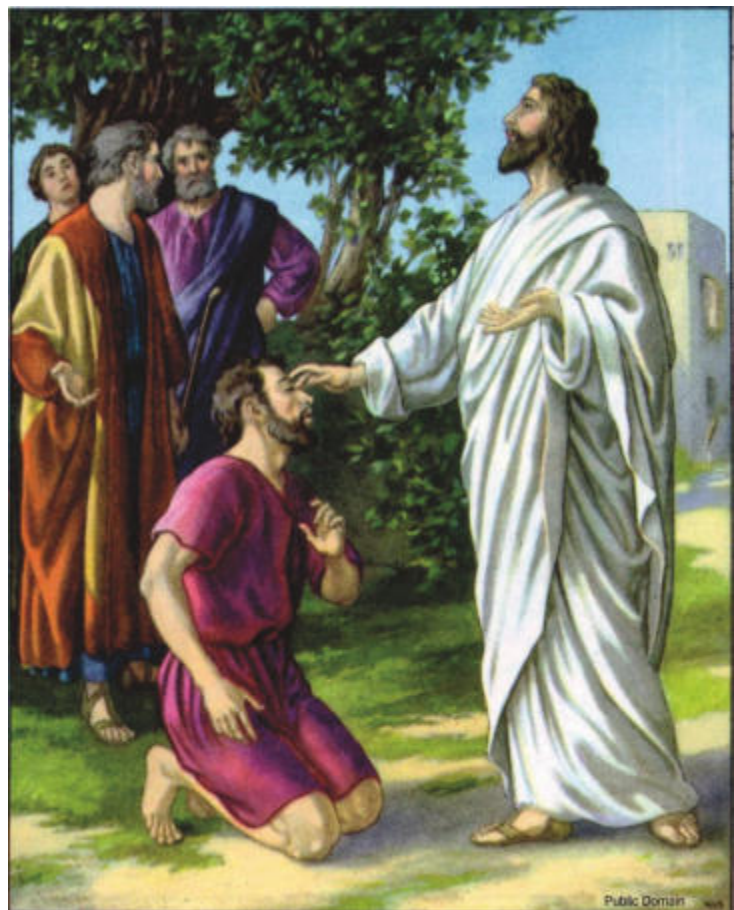

40 Hours Devotion

The Traditional 40 Hours Devotion will be held at ICC

beginning with Mass, Exposition and Procession **Sunday February 14, at 1:00 p.m.**, and concluding with Mass, Procession, and Reposition at **6:45 a.m.** on **Tuesday, February 16. At least two adorers are needed for each of the 40 hours, so please sign up for one or more hours. Sign-up sheets are posted in the vestibule.**

Lenten Regulations

The yearly "40-day retreat" of Lent begins this Wednesday. The current law of the Church which binds under sin is as follows:

Fasting: All Catholics aged 18 through 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means that only one full meal is allowed along with two smaller meals which, together, do not equal the normal full meal. Eating between meals is not allowed on these days. Non-nutritious beverages such as coffee or tea do not break the fast.

Abstinence: All Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from all meat and soups and gravies made from meat on every Friday during Lent including Good Friday and Ash Wednesday. Fish, seafood, etc. is permitted on these days.

Sundays are not counted among the 40 days of Lent.

During Lent the 5:30 p.m. Friday Low Mass will instead be at **5:15 p.m. (No confessions beforehand.)** The Stations of the Cross will be held immediately after Mass. **On First Fridays, March 5 and April 2, Stations will be held at 6:15 p.m. with Mass at 7:00 p.m.**
