The Gospel reading today presents us with yet another tense exchange from the Holy Gospel according to St. John. Near the closing, Our Lord says, "Before Abraham came to be, I Am." This is clearly a reference -- which those present when the event occurred also realized -- to Exodus 3: 14, in which God says of Himself, "I Am Who Am." It is, therefore, an assertion of the divinity of Jesus Christ, His eternity, and everything else that applies only to God. Christ saves us because he is a *man*; He saves us because He is God.
